


Saint Mary Cathedral 203 E. 10th St. Austin, TX 78701-2406 (512) 476-6182

Saint Mary Cathedral is located on East 10th Street, between Brazos Street and San Jacinto Boulevard in downtown Austin. Visitors to Saint Mary Cathedral may validate their parking ticket during the week in the evenings after 5pm and on the weekends only. The entrance to Capitol Towers Parking Garage is located off San Jacinto Boulevard. Visitors attending Mass may validate their own parking ticket in the school gym, within the hours listed above. You may park in any of the unmarked parking spaces--usually located on the 5th floor and up. Cathedral Parking Map (not to scale):



It is recommended that you park in the **Capitol Tower Parking Garage behind the Cathedral**. The entrance is located on San Jacinto Street right after the alley between 10th and 9th Street.

You may validate your ticket before leaving.

AFTER 5PM ON WEEKDAYS OR ON THE WEEKENDS:

Press the button at the Entrance Gate Kiosk upon entering the garage to be issued a parking ticket. Take the ticket with you to the elevator and select "Level 2" (PG).

You may park on the 5th floor where the reserve parking signs say St. Mary Cathedral or anywhere there are no reserved parking signs.

- Weekends Mass and Weddings: take the elevator to 2nd floor. You will be in the school gym.
- Validate your parking ticket upon arriving or leaving, using the machine located just outside the door leading into the gym.
- Streets surrounding the Cathedral on all sides are lined with parking meters, which are free Monday-Wednesday after 6:00 p.m. and all day on Sunday. Please read the parking restrictions on the meters before leaving your vehicle.

For weddings:

- Alley parking is recommended for handicap and parents/grandparents of the couple, and visiting clergy only.
- Handicap parking violators can incur a \$500 fine from the City of Austin.
