Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered most
Sundays after the 12:30 pm Mass. Arrangements
must be made in advance by calling the Parish
Office. First time parents are required to attend a
Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held
the second Tuesday of every month at 7:30 pm in the
John Paul II Room in the Annex.

No pre-registration is necessary.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every
Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm and anytime by
appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage requires that the
couple contact the Church at least 6 months before a
planned wedding date. No other arrangements
should be made until the couple meets with a parish
priest and the date and time are confirmed. One of
the couple must be a member of the parish.
Attendance at a Pre-Cana marriage preparation
program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan
policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and
those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery.
Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy and
weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy
Communion. To place a homebound individual on the
Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish
Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to
register. In order to receive the sacraments of
Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or Letters of
Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation,
you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children
who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher
education and continue to reside within our area,
should become individually registered parishioners.

Consultation of the Faithful and Clergy for the 2015 Synod of Bishops in Rome

Last fall, the Synod of Bishops gathered in Rome to discuss the topic "The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization." At the end of their meetings, they issued a final document; an official summary of their findings. Now, this document will be used to prepare for the next Synod of Bishops scheduled to take place in Rome from October 4th through the 25th. The topic this time will be "The Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and Contemporary World."

At this time, the Office of the Synod of Bishops invites all of us to have input into the preparatory process. An introduction and summary of the 2014 Synod, along with questions for consultation, can be found on the Archdiocesan website at www.archphila.org.

Responses to those questions are to be submitted by Monday, March 9th. The online instrument will automatically submit participants' responses to the Archdiocese. All responses will be collated and will form a general response of the clergy and faithful of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. If you wish to participate but do not have access to the Internet, you may request a hard copy of the consultation instrument by contacting the Office for Communications at 215-587-3747. Again, all responses (online and hard copy) must be received by the Office of the Synod no later than **Monday, March 9, 2015**.

February 2015:

Chapter 4: Two Become One



Our first three chapters reviewed basic Christian faith. We saw how confidence in Jesus opens the door to faith, enabling us to know God and what God has done in history. God creates male and female in his image, and makes a covenant with Israel and the Church. God is faithful to his promises, even when we sin. Because God loved us in this way, we spend our lives trying to return our love to God and share it with our neighbor. In this month's chapter and in the chapters to come, we will study the implications of these doctrines for marriage and the family. When husband and wife promise to love each other as God loves us all, they make a commitment to love not only romantically, but also with mercy and forgiveness. Our culture sometimes teaches us to think of marriage as a negotiable contract between two individuals who happen to feel sexual chemistry. This view of love is a recipe for instability, since it is still premised on individualism and the waxing and waning of romantic feelings. The Church's alternative account of love enables us to transcend the culture of individualism and become who we were created to be. Founded on Christ, sustained in the sacraments, Catholic marriage builds humility and self-sacrifice into the dynamic between male and female. As this month's chapter explains in more detail, sacramental marriage creates intimate communion even in times of suffering and hardship. "Love is our mission," as our catechism's title declares, because Christ's love frees us from false, shrunken accounts of love and makes us fully alive.

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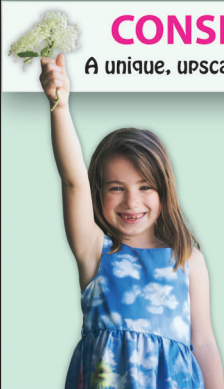
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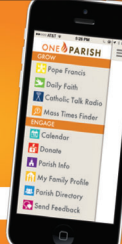
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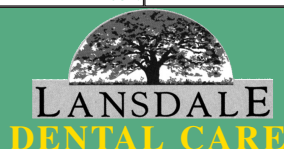
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
