Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered most
Sundays after the 12:30 pm Mass. Arrangements
must be made in advance by calling the Parish
Office. First time parents are required to attend a
Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held
the second Tuesday of every month at 7:30 pm in the
John Paul II Room in the Annex.

No pre-registration is necessary.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every
Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm and anytime by
appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage requires that the
couple contact the Church at least 6 months before a
planned wedding date. No other arrangements
should be made until the couple meets with a parish
priest and the date and time are confirmed. One of
the couple must be a member of the parish.
Attendance at a Pre-Cana marriage preparation
program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan
policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and
those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery.
Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy and
weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy
Communion. To place a homebound individual on the
Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish
Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to
register. In order to receive the sacraments of
Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or Letters of
Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation,
you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children
who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher
education and continue to reside within our area,
should become individually registered parishioners.

February 2015:

Chapter 4: Two Become One

Our first three chapters reviewed basic Christian faith. We saw how confidence in Jesus opens the door to faith, enabling us to know God and what God has done in history. God creates male and female in his image, and makes a covenant with Israel and the Church. God is faithful to his promises, even when we sin. Because God loved us in this way, we spend our lives trying to return our love to God and share it with our neighbor. In this month's chapter and in the chapters to come, we will study the implications of these doctrines for marriage and the family. When husband and wife promise to love each other as God loves us all, they make a commitment to love not only romantically, but also with mercy and forgiveness. Our culture sometimes teaches us to think of marriage as a negotiable contract between two individuals who happen to feel sexual chemistry. This view of love is a recipe for instability, since it is still premised on individualism and the waxing and waning of romantic feelings. The Church's alternative account of love enables us to transcend the culture of individualism and become who we were created to be. Founded on Christ, sustained in the sacraments, Catholic marriage builds humility and self-sacrifice into the dynamic between male and female. As this month's chapter explains in more detail, sacramental marriage creates intimate communion even in times of suffering and hardship. "Love is our mission," as our catechism's title declares, because Christ's love frees us from false, shrunken accounts of love and makes us fully alive.

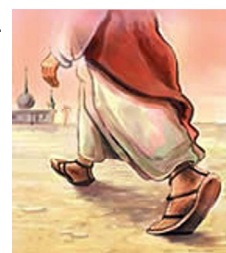
- 1) Grab a pan and a lid from the closet in the small kitchen in the narthex of the church.
- 2) Cook and FREEZE a casserole of your choosing.
- 3) Label your casserole with the date prepared in marker on the lid or on a sticky note taped to the lid.
- 4) Place your FROZEN casserole in the flat freezer in that kitchen.
- 5) IF the freezer is full, please alert someone at the church and place your casserole in the upright freezer for the time being. If that freezer is also full, please alert church staff right away!
- 6) Make sure your casserole lid is on tight because if the lid comes off, the casserole may not be able to be used.

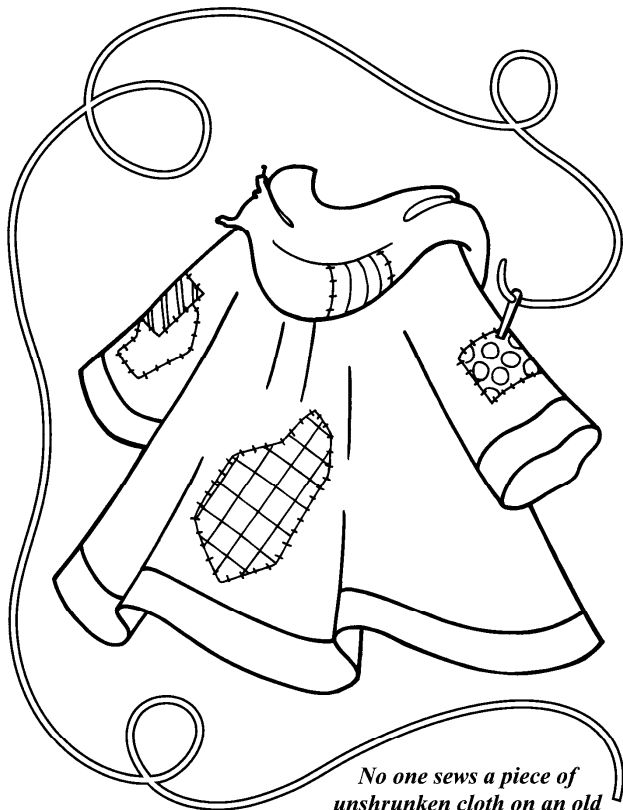


Please pray for our group as we continue to be good stewards of the body God has given us so that we may walk in faith and grow stronger both spiritually and physically!

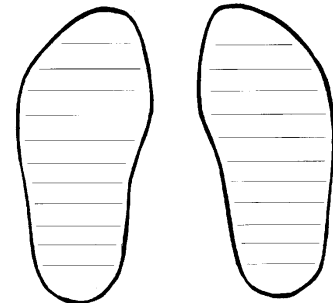
PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING

Each year on the First Sunday of Lent, the Gospel tells us that the Spirit led Jesus into the desert. He stayed there for forty days, praying and fasting, and he faced many challenges. Each year we are led by God's Spirit on a journey of forty days through Lent. Lent challenges us to change our lives and to walk in the footsteps of Jesus. The three practices of Lent—**prayer**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving**—are our helpers and guides.

Try this Lenten activity. Trace an outline of your feet or shoes on cardboard or construction paper. Cut them out and write the words prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Place the feet on the floor next to your bed where you will be sure to step on them each morning. Every day they will remind you to walk in the footsteps of Jesus and to pray, fast, and give alms.

Lent ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. For the next forty days keep a chart of your Lenten practices on your "footprints." What prayers will you say? When will you pray? What will you do without—a video game, a TV show, certain foods? How will you help the poor? What time or goods or money will you contribute? Look at your charts on Holy Thursday and reflect on how you have kept the Lenten practices.

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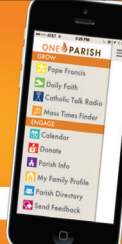
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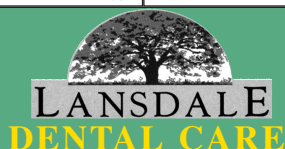
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
