Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered most
Sundays after the 12:30 pm Mass. **Arrangements**
must be made in advance by calling the Parish
Office. First time parents are required to attend a
Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held
the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm.
No pre-registration is necessary.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every
Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Sundays immediately
following the 9:00 am Mass; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by
contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact
the church at least 6 months before a planned wed-
ding date. No other arrangements should be made
until the couple meets with a parish priest and the
date and time are confirmed. One party must be a
member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage
Preparation program is required in accordance with
Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and
those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery.
Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy and
weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy
Communion. To place a homebound individual on
the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish
Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to
register. In order to receive the sacraments of
Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or Letters of
Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation,
you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children
who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher
education and continue to reside within our area,
should become individually registered parishioners.

Sunday Mass Schedule to Change NEXT WEEK

In recent years, there have been informal discussions about the scheduled time of our last Sunday Mass. We average about 250 congregants each week and struggle to provide a sufficient number of liturgical ministers (that is, lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, music ministers, altar servers, and ushers) at the 12:30 pm Mass. After discussing this pastoral issue more formally with our parish staff, Parish Pastoral Council, and Liturgy Committee, **Monsignor Conway has made the decision to change our Sunday Mass schedule effective Sunday, January 6, 2019. The Vigil Mass on Saturday evening will remain at 5:15 pm. The schedule on Sunday will be 7:30 am, 9:00 am, 10:30 am, and 12:00 pm.** The bottom line is that the time of the last two Masses of the day will change. Hopefully the half-hour change to an earlier time for our last Mass of the day will make it possible for more liturgical ministers to step up to assist in order to ensure the manner of Eucharistic celebration prescribed by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal.

Staff members have contacted those who have requested Sunday Mass intentions so that they are aware of this change. This coming spring, First Holy Communion will be scheduled at 12:00 pm; not 12:30 pm. Also, Baptisms scheduled for Sundays will begin shortly after the conclusion of the 12:00 pm Mass. Included in this year's Advent/Christmas mailing, every registered household received a refrigerator magnet listing the new Mass times. This will serve as a reminder until we all get used to the revised times.

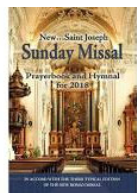

Tuesday, January 1st is the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God; a holyday of obligation.

Masses are scheduled for Monday, December 31st, at 5:15 pm; and on Tuesday, January 1st, at 7:30, 9:00, and 10:45 am; 12:30 pm.

These sessions are structured with a particular topic presented by trained facilitators, followed by group sharing and discussion. Bereaved adults are welcome to attend any or all meetings.

February 14, 2019: Surviving Stress and Loneliness

March 14, 2019: Feelings of Denial, Bargaining, and Guilt

A Letter to the Church

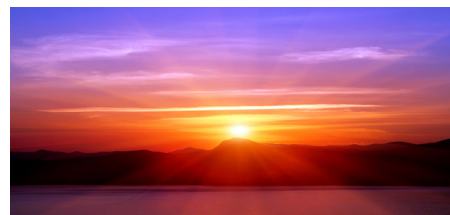
How baffling you are, oh Church,

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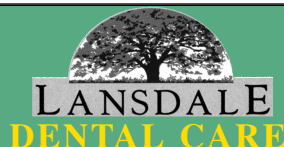
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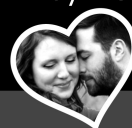
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
