Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered **most**
Sundays after the 12:00 pm Mass. **Arrangements**
must be made in advance by calling the Parish
Office. First time parents are required to attend a
Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held
the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. No
pre-registration is necessary.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every
Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Sundays immediately
following the 9:00 am Mass; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled
by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must
contact the church at least 6 months before a
planned wedding date. No other arrangements
should be made until the couple meets with a parish
priest and the date and time are confirmed. One
party must be a member of the parish. Attendance
at a Marriage Preparation program is required in
accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying
and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for
surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy
and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy
Communion. To place a homebound individual on
the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish
Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to
register. In order to receive the sacraments of
Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or Letters of
Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation,
you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children
who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher
education and continue to reside within our area,
should become individually registered parishioners.

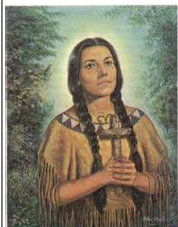

Restrictions for Attending Public Masses

Remain in Place at MMR Church

Recently, Father Dennis Gill (Director of the Office for Divine Worship) hosted a webinar to present to parishes the adjusted restrictions for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's "green phase" and the Archdiocesan "open phase." This phase began on Friday, June 26th. However, for all practical purposes, the restrictions you have experienced over the past few weeks at MMR Church will remain in place as we move into this new phase. The directives we have been following are posted on our parish website. For now, **the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holydays also remains in place.**

Yes, we are moving into a more relaxed phase; but most of the aspects of the gradual reopening process right now do not affect what we Catholics do at church. Yes, we will be permitted to fill 75% of our seating capacity in the green phase (in contrast to 50% in the yellow phase). But, the fact is, we've been averaging much less than 50% of our capacity since moving into the yellow phase. The bottom line is that this is pretty much a moot point.



There is, however, a significant adjustment in the restrictions that will affect a segment of our community. Regarding pastoral visits to the sick, the following was put forth: **Deacons and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion may resume visits with Holy Communion to the homebound and medical facilities provided there is mutual agreement between the Communion minister, the facility, and those to be visited.** To date, only clergy may visit a patient/resident in a medical facility. Even then, it's only in extreme cases. So, the issue at hand is our homebound parishioners. Within the next several days, our parish staff members will be contacting our extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion; and our extraordinary ministers will be contacting parishioners who are on our homebound list. We will determine where there is "mutual agreement," and schedule home visits with Holy Communion. There is no expectation from your parish priests in this regard. If either extraordinary minister or homebound parishioner does not feel that they are ready to visit or be visited, please wait. Meanwhile, let us continue to pray for each other's safety, good health, and (above all) spiritual well-being.

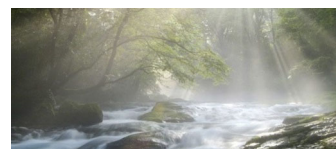

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I have always wanted to be one of those people with an amazing green thumb, who can somehow encourage plants to grow in abundance. It's an ongoing joke in my family, unfortunately, that the only plant that has survived in my care is a cactus that requires very little work or water!

Today's Scriptures are steeped in the language of gardening and farming - of sowing seeds, of bounty, fruitfulness, abundance, of the ground that is tilled. This language was so familiar to the Israelites, and so these passages would have held great meaning for them and would have resonated with their life experience. We may find that in the modern world we struggle to connect with the imagery and language used here.

We can certainly understand and imagine many ways we bear fruit as Christians - think of the fruits of the Spirit: charity, generosity, joy, gentleness, peace, faithfulness, patience, modesty, kindness, self-control, goodness, chastity. But what does it mean to have a foundation of good soil, as Jesus talks about in the Gospel?

Essentially Jesus is comparing the soil to one's soul. Am I truly open to God's Word? Is your heart open to knowing the person of Jesus? Is your heart open to following Jesus? Am I open to God's will and willing to be molded by God? Jesus tells us in the Gospel that one who is truly open to hearing and understanding God's Word - God's Revelation through the Scriptures and the person of Christ - will bear much fruit in the world.

This week let's reflect on the type of ground we most connect with at this moment. Perhaps we can all pray for more openness to understand who God is and how He is present and acting in our lives.

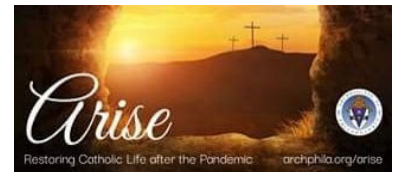

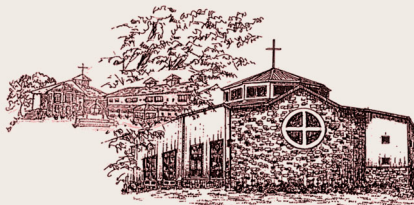
