Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered most Sundays after the 12:00 pm Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. No pre-registration is necessary.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Sundays immediately following the 9:00 am Mass; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a parish priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should become individually registered parishioners.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's readings bring to mind the biblical concept of repentance. Repentance can strike us as a negative term - one that may evoke fire and brimstone imagery. What is it really? Repentance is really a conversion of heart. It involves an invitation to surrender - acknowledging and accepting that God is Lord and Savior of my life - and to entrust myself to God's love, goodness, and mercy. It involves sorrow - understanding my sins and sorrow for how my actions have damaged my relationship with God, others, and myself. It involves transformation, getting hit to the heart so deeply that it changes the very way we live, but only by the grace of God's power and not our own. Repentance allows us the opportunity to live free from all that keeps God at a distance, so that we can be the people God intended us to be. Oh the sweet relief when we realize that Jesus has already taken the burden upon Himself - then we can say "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me" (Psalm 51:10).

My prayer for us all this week:

Lord, let the waters of our baptism wash us anew. Renew our hearts and minds. Protect us against the wickedness and snares of the devil. Guide us by Your Light. Give us eyes to see You, Your action in our lives and in the world, and how we can be Your hands to those we encounter each day. Shower Your mercy upon us. Hear our cries of sorrow - for all of the ways we have wronged You, our brothers and sisters, and ourselves. Compel us to pray, to draw closer to You, to be conformed to You. Strengthen us to be "good seeds...children of the kingdom". Encourage us in hope. Enliven us with love and mercy. Amen!

CRS Spotlight

A coalition of faith-based organizations is asking Congress to take immediate action to fund efforts to fight the COVID-19 pandemic overseas. "If we don't beat COVID-19 everywhere, we can't beat it anywhere," said Catholic Relief Services, one of the letter's signatories, in a recent press release. CRS is urging an authorization of \$10 - 15 billion, which equates to about 0.005% of the \$3 trillion Congress has authorized so far for domestic pandemic relief. The letter stated, "At this critical moment, we cannot turn our back on our brothers and sisters around the world. As a nation, we have both the ability and obligation to provide resources which will prevent the worldwide spread of this disease and alleviate the suffering of those afflicted – and in so doing, we are certain it will also protect us here at home as well." 


