

#### Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered most Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office. First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the parish website to register online: <a href="https://mmredeemer.org/baptism">https://mmredeemer.org/baptism</a>.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Sundays immediately following the 9:30 am Mass; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a parish priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

**Communion Calls** are made monthly by clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

#### **New Registrations**

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.



# Tips for Supporting Someone Grieving During the Holidays



- Be supportive of the way the person chooses to handle the holidays. Some may wish to follow traditions; others may choose to avoid customs of the past and do something new. It's okay to do things differently.
- Invite the person to join you or your family during the holidays. You might invite them to join you for a religious service or at a holiday meal where they are a guest.
- Donate a gift or money in memory of the person's loved one. Remind the person that his or her loved one is not forgotten.
- Never tell someone that he or she should be "over it." Instead, give the person hope that, eventually, he or she will enjoy the holidays again.
- 5. **Be willing to listen.** Active listening from friends and family is an important step to help some cope with grief and heal.
- Remind the person that you are thinking of him or her and the loved one who died.
   Cards, phone calls and visits are great ways to stay in touch.
- 7. Follow up after the holidays to check in.
  Given the activity of the season, some people may make it through the holidays without any issues but they might find the post-holiday period to be more difficult. So checking in after the holidays to see how he or she may be doing is helpful.

Your grief journey can be overwhelming or even confusing at times. The Bereavement Ministry of Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Parish, in conjunction with St. Stanislaus Parish, is here to help you, guide you, and prayerfully support you as you heal.



On the second Thursday of each month, there is a general support group meeting offered at the two parishes. There is a morning session offered at Mary, Mother of the Redeemer from 10:00 to 11:30 am, and an evening session offered at St. Stanislaus from 7:00 to 8:30 pm. These sessions are structured with a particular topic presented by trained facilitators, followed by group sharing and discussion. Bereaved adults are welcome to attend any or all meetings.

#### Do you need to make an RMD for your IRA?

You may qualify for tax benefits when you give to charities directly from your IRA.

If you wish to support Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Church & School, you can make a gift from an IRA free of federal income tax on your withdrawal (this year and in future years) if you meet the following criteria:

- 1. Are age  $70 \frac{1}{2}$  or older on the day of the gift.
- 2. Transfer up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA to one or more qualified charities such as Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Parish.
  - Note: This opportunity applies only to IRAs and not to other types of retirement plans.
- 3. Do not receive any goods or services in return for the rollover gift.

#### You can benefit when you:

- 1. Wish to make a gift without using cash or other assets.
- 2. Do not need all or a portion of your IRA income.
- 3. Are paying too much in taxes and are looking to reduce your income.
- 4. Want to increase your normal level of giving. An IRA rollover gift does not count towards the 50% annual limitation on charitable gifts.

#### **Phishing Scam Affecting** Archdiocesan Parishes

A phishing scam has been affecting a number of parishes within the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. This scam involves parishioners receiving a text message, email, or robotic call from a source alleging to be the pastor of the local parish, and asking parishioners to purchase gift cards for a special need and to send the gift card numbers and purchase receipt back to the scammer claiming to be the pastor.

Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Parish wants to remind our parishioners to report any suspicious requests for donations to law enforcement. MMR Parish fund-raising requests are most commonly mailed directly to potential donors, included in a weekly parish or school email, or as an entry in the weekly parish bulletin. If you receive a request that does not conform to one of MMR's standard forms of communication, please call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to confirm it is a legitimate request.

Our goal is to help each parishioner feel welcomed, accepted and connected with our Catholic community. That's why we implemented several activities over the past few years to give our parishioners the opportunity to build relationships that go beyond the typical friendly wave at Mass.

Living out the true meaning of Christian community means not only worshiping together, but also having fun together and helping each other. This past year, we relaunched our New Member Registration process, which will help us to more effectively connect new parish members into our vibrant community and make resources they may need available. With the many new families joining our parish, we felt that an improved on-boarding process would help us engage with our new members and serve them better.

Our new Catholic Women's Group was formed to create a warm environment for women to encourage one another in their journeys of faith. Our "Families With Young Children" ministry hosts events that bring young families together for fun and faith sharing.




