Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a parish priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.





A message from the Catholic Social Teaching Committee

We invite you to reflect on the principles of ***Rights and Responsibilities, Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, Solidarity, and Call to Family, Community and Participation.*** Our parish community collects food in our Mother Teresa's Cupboard food bins located in the Parish Hall for the Patrician Society and Martha's Food Pantry in Norristown who serve over 6,000 families in our area in need of food, personal care items, and other supplies.

We suggest adding a line to your weekly grocery shopping list for "Food Banks." Just one non-perishable food item will make such a difference. No-one would say that one jar will feed many people, but if 50 parishioners add "one jar", that would result in 50 jars per week, or about 200 jars per month. Look for our monthly Food Bin reminders as we do our part to end hunger in our area. Thank you!

CRS Spotlight

Your voice is urgently needed! The House of Representatives recently voted to pass a package of cuts, called rescissions, that were requested by the White House. This is the first of many packages expected to eliminate even more lifesaving international assistance programs. Over the next several weeks, the Senate will consider the package. Please tell your senator to oppose cuts!

Countless lives are at risk. This package proposes cancelling funding for programming focused on supporting pregnant mothers and their children, providing emergency food, preventing infectious diseases and ensuring children, families and communities can move out of poverty over the long-term. At this very same moment, Congress is also assessing support for lifesaving aid in the fiscal year 2026 federal budget. Approving this new package of cuts would signal approval for shrinking or eliminating funding for international poverty-reducing programs in future budgets.
