## Sacraments

**The Sacrament of Baptism** is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

**The Sacrament of Marriage** may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a parish priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

**Communion Calls** are made monthly by clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

## New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.



Your grief journey can be overwhelming or even confusing at times. The Bereavement Ministry of Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Parish, in conjunction with St. Stanislaus Parish, is here to help you, guide you, and prayerfully support you as you heal.



**On the second Thursday of each month, there is a general support group meeting offered at the two parishes.** There is a morning session offered at Mary, Mother of the Redeemer from 10:00 to 11:30 am, and an evening session offered at St. Stanislaus from 7:00 to 8:30 pm. These sessions are structured with a particular topic presented by trained facilitators, followed by group sharing and discussion. Bereaved adults are welcome to attend any or all meetings.

**October 9, 2025:** Your Grief Journey is Your Own

**November 13, 2025:** Understanding the Process of Grief

**December 11, 2025:** Coping with the Holidays when You Are Grieving

Beginning in October 2025, MMR Parish will offer the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola through daily personal prayer and a weekly small group sharing (3-5 persons), referred to as the Retreat in Daily Life, the Ignatian 30-day retreat held over 30 weeks. The small group will be in-person and/or virtual, depending on the participants' needs.

To see if you would like to try this "school of prayer," a Prayer Suggestion will be offered each week to whet your appetite.

**Prayer Suggestion for this week:** We notice that Jesus grows up in a particular social, economic, political, and religious context. I pray for the grace to know Jesus more intimately, to love him more intensely, and to follow him more closely. Read Luke 2: 21-38.

## CRS Spotlight

Did you know that international humanitarian aid makes the world, including the United States, safer? International humanitarian aid programs help people get an education and find jobs, reducing future aid needs. It supports fragile governments in providing services like health care and building infrastructure. It also prevents conflicts and promotes peace, making the world - including the United States - safer. When young people feel connected to society, they are less likely to turn to extremism. When farmers can earn a living from the land, they are less likely to migrate. Cutting aid could lead to more conflict, increased migration, more disease outbreaks and a lack of basic needs. It compromises hard-won progress toward peace and stability in areas where the US has invested to keep our country safe.

CRS has long and enduring relationships with trusted local Church partners - organizations deeply rooted in the communities we serve. They know the people, the culture, the needs. Supporting these networks strengthens the United States' global influence and stability. In Iraq, a US-funded project empowered 13,000 young people to promote peace and create job opportunities - part of ongoing efforts to rebuild after an invasion. The initiative aimed to build trust between communities and provide training in business development, with the goal of reducing conflict and radicalization. The project abruptly ended with the Trump administration's cuts to international humanitarian aid, halting progress in a region still recovering from conflict.
