Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the Parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a Parish Priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by Clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.



Phishing Scam Affecting MMR Parish

A phishing scam is affecting a number of parishes within the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. This scam involves parishioners receiving a text, email, or robotic call from a source alleging to be the Pastor of the local parish. The caller asks parishioners to purchase gift cards for a special need and to send the gift card numbers and purchase receipt back to the scammer claiming to be the Pastor.

Mary, Mother of the Redeemer Parish reminds our parishioners to report any suspicious requests for donations to law enforcement. MMR Parish fund-raising requests are most commonly mailed through the USPS directly to potential donors, included in a weekly parish or school email, or as an entry in the weekly parish bulletin. If you receive a request that does not conform to one of MMR's standard forms of communication, please call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to confirm it is a legitimate request.

The third week in January is Healthy Weight Week! Everyone deserves a healthy meal. We invite you to reflect on the principles of **Rights and Responsibilities, Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, Solidarity, and Call to Family, Community and Participation.** Our parish community collects food in our Mother Teresa's Cupboard food bins located in the Parish Center Lobby for the Patrician Society and Martha's Food Pantry in Norristown who serve over 6,000 families in our area in need of food, personal care items, and other supplies. We suggest adding a line to your weekly grocery shopping list for "Food Banks." Just one box of healthy snack bars, low sodium soups or beans or vegetables will make such a difference. No-one would say that one can or box of food will feed many people, but if 50 parishioners add "one can or box", that would result in 50 cans or boxes per week, or about 200 cans or boxes per month. Look for our monthly Food Bin reminders as we do our part to end hunger in our area. **Thank you!**

Catechetical Institute February Courses


