## Sacraments

**The Sacrament of Baptism** is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the Parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

**The Sacrament of Marriage** may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a Parish Priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

**Communion Calls** are made monthly by Clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

## New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.







## CRS Spotlight

Hurricane Melissa made landfall in Jamaica as a powerful Category 5 storm in October of 2025, causing devastation and extensive flooding. At its peak, Hurricane Melissa reached winds of 185 mph, making it one of the most intense Atlantic storms in more than a century — surpassing even Hurricane Katrina. In some communities, an assessment led by Caritas Antilles and Jamaican diocesan officials found that more than 90% of households suffered major or total housing damage, leaving many families sheltering in partially collapsed homes. Families lost personal belongings and access to food and basic goods, as well as jobs and income.

During emergencies like Hurricane Melissa, people often turn to faith-based and local organizations for help. There is a lot to quickly coordinate, from assessing the impact of the emergency to identifying those most in need, collecting community feedback, arranging transportation to safe areas or to distribution sites, and following safeguarding policies. Catholic Relief Services' approach to empowering local people and organizations is rooted in the Catholic social teaching principle of subsidiarity — the belief that people closest to the problem are best positioned to solve it. By strengthening local leadership and institutions through its EMPOWER initiative, CRS honors the dignity of each person and community, accompanying local institutions in serving the common good.
