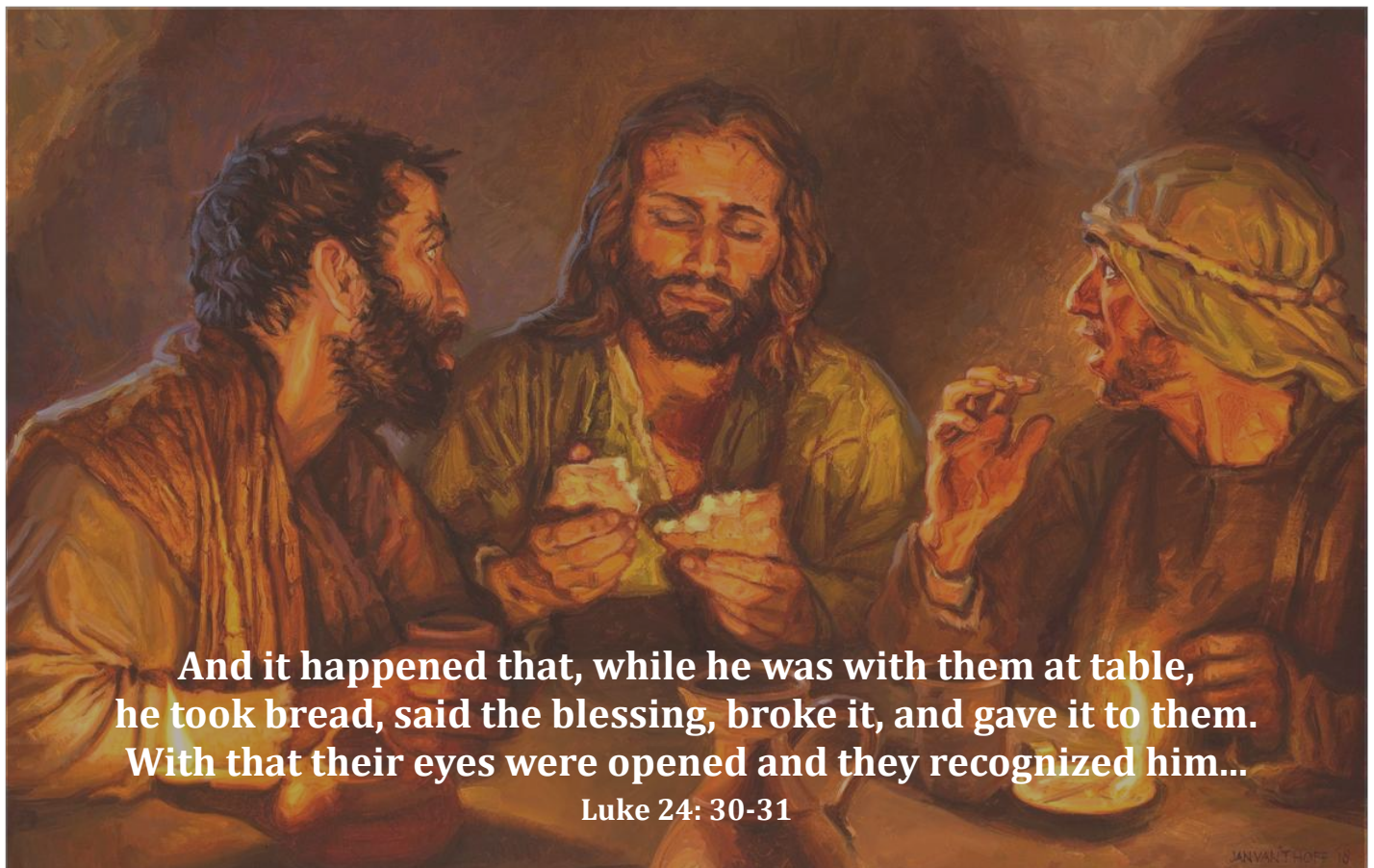

## Sacraments

**The Sacrament of Baptism** is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the Parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

**The Sacrament of Marriage** may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a Parish Priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

**Communion Calls** are made monthly by Clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

## New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.

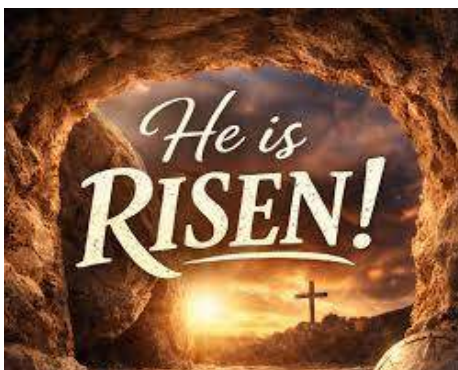

## The 10:10 Challenge

Discipleship Practice of the Week

### Week 8 – Call on Mary and the Saints

The promise of Baptism is a mystical union with Christ that frees us not only from sin but from the consequence of sin — death itself. United to Jesus, we are invited to resurrection, to life everlasting. As St. Paul puts it: “If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him” (Romans 6:8). The people we call saints are those who responded to this invitation in their lives and who now share in Christ’s resurrected life in Heaven. The Church teaches that all of us are called to this holiness and fullness of Christian life, following God faithfully however he leads us. Since the early centuries of the Church, we have venerated and asked for the prayers of those disciples who did just that.

Use the Regina Coeli prayer on this page to call on Mary’s intercession. To call on more saints, include a short litany of favorites (St. \_\_\_\_\_, pray for us!) to close your prayer. The Angelus is traditionally prayed at noon in honor of Mary’s great “yes” to God leading to the Incarnation. During the Easter season, the Regina Coeli (“Queen of Heaven”) is said in place of the Angelus in celebration of the Resurrection.

#### **The Regina Coeli**

V/. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia!

R/. For he whom you merited to bear, alleluia!

V/. Has risen, as he said, alleluia!

R/. Pray for us to God, alleluia!

V/. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia!

R/. Because the Lord is truly risen, alleluia!

O God, who by the Resurrection of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, granted joy to the whole world, grant, we beseech you, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, his Mother, we may enjoy the happiness of eternal life, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

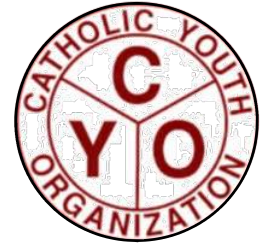
