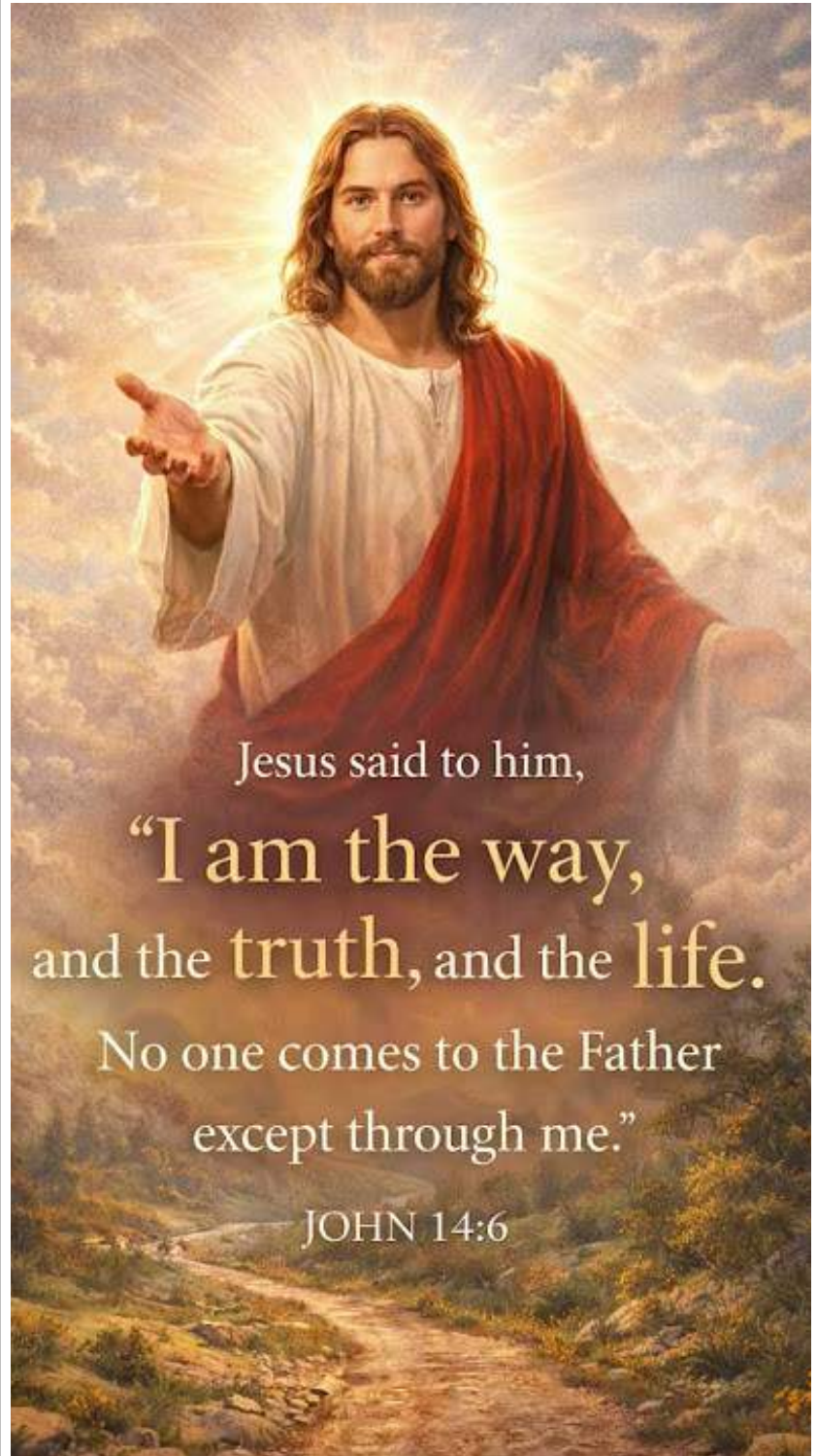

Sacraments

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered **most** Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. **Arrangements must be made in advance by calling the Parish Office.** First time parents are required to attend a Pre-Jordan class before the baptism. They are held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is required, visit the Parish website to register online: <https://mmredeemer.org/baptism>.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered every Saturday, 4:00 to 4:45 pm; Mondays, 6:00 to 7:00 pm; and anytime by appointment.

The Sacrament of Marriage may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must contact the church at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a Parish Priest and the date and time are confirmed. One party must be a member of the parish. Attendance at a Marriage Preparation program is required in accordance with Archdiocesan policy.

Anointing of the Sick is available to the dying and those who are elderly, sick, or preparing for surgery. Please contact the Parish Office.

Communion Calls are made monthly by Clergy and weekly by Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. To place a homebound individual on the Communion Call list, call the Parish Office.

New Registrations

Welcome new parishioners! You may call the Parish Office at 215-362-7400 to make an appointment to register. In order to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage, or to obtain Letters of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a registered parishioner. Also, children who turn 26 years of age, or complete higher education and continue to reside within our area, should register individually as parishioners.

The 10:10 Challenge

Discipleship Practice of the Week

Week 10 – Share the Good News

Imagine you're in heaven, and someone you know comes to find you. They've been eager to tell you something. Here's what they say: Friend, I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for pointing me to Jesus. You played an important role in my story. I know now just how much you prayed for me. And even when I was running hard away from God and the Church, I knew something of the love of Jesus because of your attentiveness and compassion for me. You didn't preach at me or judge me. You just kept on praying and loving. And when I was ready to hear more, when my heart was finally starting to soften, you shared more of your life in Christ with me. You taught me the ways of eternal life. Thank you.

Could there be any greater honor than hearing words like this? Perhaps hearing "well done, my good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21) from the King of kings himself would take the cake. The good news of God's Kingdom and love, made known to us in Jesus, is too good not to share with the world. If you're baptized, you have a unique mission to be and share the good news of God's love with the world in a way no one else can. If you're confirmed, you have a special anointing to be supernaturally effective in this mission. Use the guidance on this page to discern with whom God may be calling you to share the good news.

DEFINE WHO: Ask the Holy Spirit to highlight one to three people (family, friends, neighbors, acquaintances) he might be calling you to "tend" or "cultivate" in his vineyard right now. Who on this list do you have the most trust or influence with? Who would be most receptive to talking with you about matters of faith?

WHAT: What can you do to build or strengthen your relationship with this person? What do they need at this time in their faith? (Conversation, answers to their questions, freedom to explore, new experiences that open their eyes, the steady comfort of a friend, the gentle but confident guidance of a mentor, additional help from a counselor, etc.)

PLAN: What next action or prayer commitment is the Holy Spirit calling you to take to begin or continue sharing the Good News with these people?

ACT: Do it! Step out in faith and act according to God's call.
