### Tiger Trot Overview

Tiger Trot (TT) is St. Ann PTO's largest annual fundraiser, with 100% of the proceeds supporting St. Ann Catholic School and Young Child Center (YCC). Last year, Tiger Trot raised over \$150,000.

- **Donations for Tiger Trot 2026 will support our \$150,000 initiative** for Classroom Enhancements. Last year, we successfully purchased new student desks to improve classroom learning environments. This year Tiger Trot will raise funds to complete those classrooms by replacing worn and unstable teacher desks and to upgrade our "specials" classrooms. Many existing teacher desks no longer support the daily demands of instruction, organization, and classroom management. Updating these essential items will enhance instructional efficiency and ensure all classrooms are fully equipped to support creativity, engagement, and student success.

### Tiger Trot Raffle FAQ

#### **Q: How does the Raffle raise money for St. Ann Catholic School & YCC?**

**A:** All of the Raffle proceeds go directly to the Tiger Trot campaign. We ask students to try and sell raffle tickets (\$25 per ticket) to friends, family and the community (anyone 18+). The top five selling tickets winners will be determined April 23rd and have the chance to win:

- KC Current ticket Package
- Foam Party
- Art Basket
- Sports Basket
- Family Game Night Basket

In addition: the raffle ticket owners have the chance to win three cash prizes of \$250, \$500 and \$1000 and these winners will be randomly selected April 23rd, need not be present to win, a physical check will be mailed to the recipient.

**Q. How else can I win?**

**A:** The grade that sells the MOST raffle tickets wins a Pajama Day and Donut Party!! There will be weekly prize drawings on Fridays for Students who sold raffle tickets that week. Each ticket sold is entered so the more sold means more chances to win!!!

**Q: Where can Tiger Trot raffle tickets be purchased?**

**A:** Tickets can be purchased a couple different ways.

- Students can sell paper tickets (They are available in the school office)
- Use the QR code ticket (It will arrive in backpack mail the week of April 20th) donors can scan the QR code to make an easy online donation.

**Tiger Trot Color Run FAQ**

**Q: What is the Color Run?**

**A:** The Color Run is an activity that is part of our final celebration to conclude our Tiger Trot fundraiser! It is a fun run/walk where the participants get “splashed” with colored food-grade cornstarch powder that is mixed with food, drug and cosmetic grade colors at designated points along the course. The powder is gluten-free and manufactured in a nut-free facility.

- Remember: wear white or light colored shirts so the color looks fun but dark bottoms are recommended.
- Although the color is not supposed to stain, take precautions for your car ride home after pick-up and pack towels in your car to cover seats/kids.

**Q: Do students have to sell Tiger Trot raffle tickets to participate?**

**A:** No – **Every** St. Ann student **can** participate in the Color Run/Tiny Trot regardless of raffle ticket sales (*but we sure hope each student sells tickets!*)
