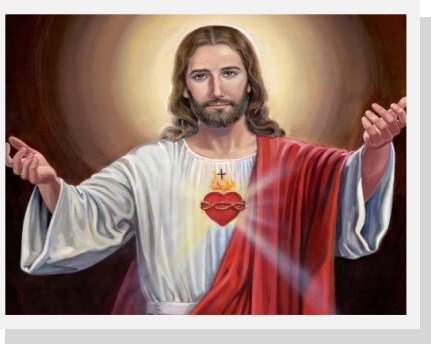

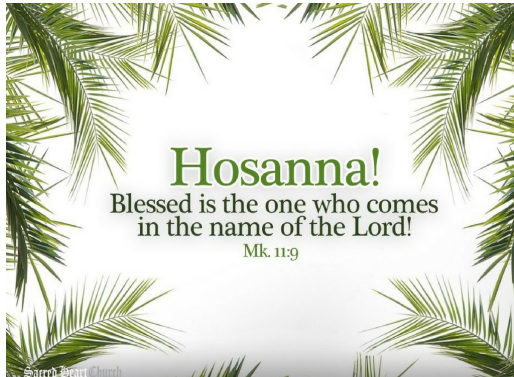

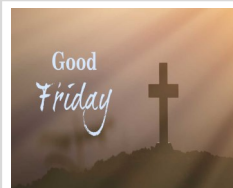
HUNGER IN OUR WORLD

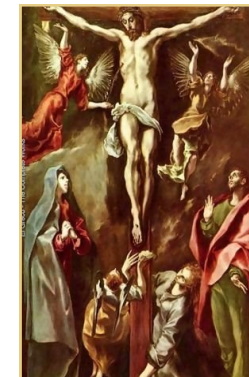
Come And Be Unburdened...
