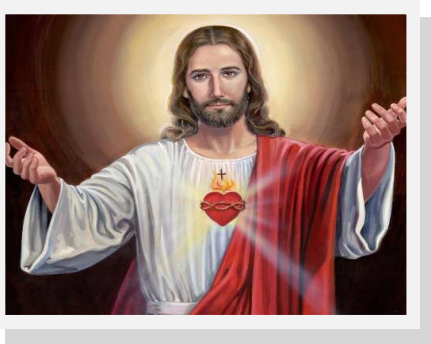

*Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 2 and ends on Holy Thursday, April 14.*

*Catholics ages 18-59 are obligated to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; one full meal may be taken with two smaller meals. Snacking between meals is not permitted.*

*Catholics age 14 and older are obligated to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.*

*Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent at 12 noon at Holy Name and 7 pm at Holy Cross.*

*Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Fridays from 6-7 pm at Holy Name and Saturdays from 8:30-9:30 am at Holy Cross.*
