

#### PREPARE FOR LENT

Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 2 and ends on Holy Thursday, April 14.

Catholics ages 18-59 are obligated to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; one full meal may be taken with two smaller meals. Snacking between meals is not permitted.

Catholics age 14 and older are obligated to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent at 12 noon at Holy Name and 7 pm at Holy Cross.

Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Fridays from 6-7 pm at Holy Name and Saturdays from 8:30-9:30 am at Holy Cross.
