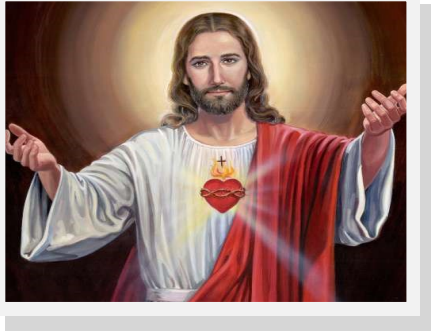

WEEKDAY MASSES JULY 2022

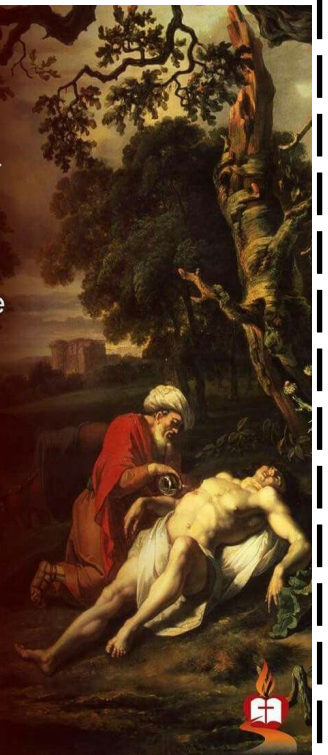
