Speaking of Monday morning and Mass, I want to extend the invitation to all to join me as we will celebrate the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and remember all our dedicated men and women of the Armed Services who made the extreme sacrifice of serving our country in the various world conflicts and paid the ultimate price, the giving up of their lives. Please take note of the innumerable American flags that are waving at HNOJ cemetery; we certainly have many who answered the call and for whom we should now answer the call to gather and remember them at the Altar of God this Memorial Day.
