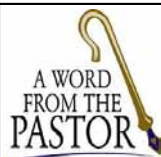
## TRIP TO NEW YORK AND MASS AT THE CATHEDRAL

These photos will be displayed for the month of November. One request however, please scotch tape a name and phone number on the back of the photo so at the end of November, if anyone forgets to pick up the picture, we can give you a call.

**CAROUSEL CAKES AND PIES** Today the Home School Association will be in the narthex after each Mass collecting orders for their Thanksgiving fundraiser. Order forms are available to pick up in the Narthex and you can bring the form back with payment next weekend November 9 and 10.



We partner with local food pantries by helping to combat the hunger problem in Rockland County. Donations are at an all time low and with the holidays approaching, we are being asked to help once again. Items requested are: peanut butter/jelly, tuna or other canned fish,
