Last Tuesday I was fortunate to be able to con-celebrate the Ordination Mass of two new bishops, at St. Patrick's Cathedral; the new bishops are: Bishop Jerry Colacicco and Bishop Ed Whalen. Bishop Colacicco has

spent most of the priesthood in the northern counties—including Sacred Heart in Newburgh, St. Columba in Hopewell and St. Joseph's in Millbrook. Bishop Whalenhas spent most of his priesthood in the City at St. Joseph-St. Thomas in Staten Island, and St. Benedict's in the Bronx. Bishop Whalen also taught Moral Theology at the Seminary for twelve years. What a blessing it is for the Archdiocese! It is a sign of growth in the Church and an example of the Apostolic Succession—the movement of the Holy Spirit from Pentecost—upon the Apostles—then passed on through other men who were chosen to assist and in time replace the first Apostles, down to the present day.

More locally, the renovations on the chapel are nearly complete, next are the security cameras. These will be placed outside and in the vestibule, but not in the chapel itself. Security cameras not only provide a record of events, but even more importantly, they can act as a deterrent. As you might recall, after meeting with the Parish Council, it was decided that the chapel should be open to all visitors from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm. From 11:00 pm to 5:00 am, the code is needed to gain entry via use of the keypad. Additionally, there is an emergency pendent which connects to the police, which has been part of the chapel from many years ago. The chapel includes people who have committed to one hour per week (guardians) and to visitors. It is the presence of the guardians that ensures the visitors have a chapel to visit. And as you might recall, we are always in need of new guardians, so if you are willing and able, please consider taking one hour per week. Consistent quiet time and prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament can change your life. Kudos to all the people who brought gifts in response to the Project Angel Tree, thank you for your generosity!

And finally, - tomorrow-is Confession Monday, from 4:00 to 8:00 PM. If you have not been to confession in a while, or if you have some things which you really need to confess—please make an effort to go and experience the sacrament of healing—given to us by Jesus Christ.
