

#### **Guidelines for the Season of Lent**

**LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE**: During the season of Lent, the Church urges the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily live through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

**Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 26**: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence, which means we don't eat meat or poultry (abstinence). Fasting requires that only one full meal may be taken per day and two smaller meals can be taken during the day, but these two smaller meals should not equal the one larger meal. Snacking between meals is not permitted.

Remember, all Fridays during Lent are designated as days of penance during which we are encouraged to practice self-denial out of gratitude for the suffering and death Jesus accepted for us. **This includes not eating meat or poultry on any Friday in Lent**.

The time for fulfilling your Easter Duty extends from the First Sunday of Lent (March 1) to Holy Trinity Sunday (June 7). What is your Easter Duty? The term "Easter Duty" is the obligation to go to confession and receive Holy Communion during the Easter season. If you already have a habit of regular confession and Communion, you can fulfill the obligation without much effort.


