This weekend we were fortunate to be visited by a seminarian from St. Joseph's Seminary which is located in the Dunwoodie section of Yonkers. William Mendoza, who is in Second Theology, is

from St. Columbanus Parish in Cortlandt Manor.

God willing, William will be celebrating his first Mass in two years. One of the reasons the Archdiocese sends seminarians to speak to parishes is to encourage young men to be open to the possibility of joining the Priesthood in the Archdiocese of New York. The last time St. Gregory's had a man ordained was in 2013, when Fr. Ken Riello was ordained at St. Patrick's Cathedral. The Church needs more men to answer their call to the priesthood, and answering that call is a bit easier when families support that decision. Sadly, families are sometimes an obstacle to men answering the call, and instead of the Priesthood, they encourage their sons to pursue a path of money and marriage. The ideal is to try to see God's will and do it, whether it is a priestly vocation or married life.

As you might know, to be ordained it is first necessary to have a bachelor's degree. Now for some men, they go to college and major in something like accounting, then work for a few years then realize, this is not it, maybe God is calling me to the Priesthood. In that case, they typically prepare for one year at the House of Formation which is located near St. John's University in Queens. This is a community of men from the Archdiocese of New York, Brooklyn and Rockville Center. Men who already have a bachelor's degree study philosophy for one year. Then after a year of formation, if they are ready they go onto St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers.

Men who need to go to college also live at the House of Formation, which is called Cathedral Seminary. Then they take classes at St. John's University, and after they graduate, if they are ready, they go onto St. Joseph Seminary in Yonkers. Then after four years of preparation, men are ordained and assigned to parishes. For the gospels to continue to spread and the sacraments to be celebrated in the parishes, we need a few more good men. How would you feel if your son, or grandson told you he was thinking about becoming a priest, hopefully that would be a happy occasion.
