Since that time I have had four assignments: St. Joseph's, Middletown; Immaculate Conception, Tuckahoe; Most Precious Blood, Walden and finally St. Gregory Barbarigo, Garnerville.

On April 27, I joined nine of my classmates to concelebrate Mass at the Seminary followed by a delicious dinner for the entire seminary community. Thanks are extended to the Rector, His Excellency Bishop James Massa, for his generous hospitality.

I am grateful to God for calling me to the Priesthood, and thankful to my family, friends and parishioners who have supported me over these years, and by the grace of God, I look forward to many more years serving Him at His Altar.

More locally, were it not for the pandemic, we would have had some kind of parish celebration - for instance coffee and donuts - which is fitting for a 25th anniversary. However, due to our limits, socializing is prevented. Although we will celebrate in the most important way—the celebration of the Mass. I will celebrate the 11:30 Mass next Sunday, May 16, with my 25th anniversary in mind. Happily my family, including my mother, will be present for Mass. After Mass, my family and I will head over to the rectory for a little while to visit.

Dear friends in the Lord:

The worldwide coronavirus outbreak restricted nonessential travel across the globe. Stay-at-home orders, physical distancing, and quarantine practices implemented to mitigate the spread of the disease revealed great and urgent needs, especially in those countries of Eastern Europe still in turbulent transition stages. There, weak economies were made more vulnerable, and those affected included the elderly as well as doctors, nurses, and medical chaplains.

Now, in spite of all of these challenges, the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (UGCC) came to the assistance of homebound senior citizens in many cities, using Church facilities to organize the work and engage both local volunteers and assistance from abroad. Volunteers prepared meals and delivered them. The UGCC mobilized its network of about 120 hospital chaplains and collected and distributed badly needed protective clothing, masks, sanitizer, and other necessities to ensure their safety as they ministered to the sick throughout the country.

Your participation in the collection for the *Church in Central and Eastern Europe* expresses your care and support for the people in Ukraine and throughout the region, especially in times of crisis and disruption.
