**CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION** Next Sunday is the feast of Corpus Christi, where we celebrate the central sacrament of our Faith, the Holy Eucharist.

In accord with our ancient tradition, we will have a procession after the 11:30 Mass. We will proceed out the front of the Church, proceed to two outside altars for Benediction and finish with the third Benediction in the Church. Please join in this expression of our belief and reverence of Christ in the Eucharist.

Today is the Feast of the Holy Trinity - a central doctrine of the Christian faith. During the first thousand years of Christianity, there was no special PASTOR feast celebrated in honor of this doctrine, but as Pope Alexander II (1073) declared, everyday of the

liturgical year was devoted to the honor and adoration of the Holy Trinity. But then from the ninth century on, various bishops of the Frankish kingdoms promoted in their own dioceses a special feast of the Holy Trinity, usually on the Sunday after Pentecost. They used prayers for Mass written by Abbot Alcuin (804). Thus, the custom of observing a special feast in honor of the Holy Trinity became increasingly popular in the northern countries in Europe. In 1334 Pope John XXII accepted the festival into the official calendar of the Western Church and ordered that henceforth it should be held everywhere on the Sunday after Pentecost. A new Mass text was written and published. It is interesting to note that the beautiful Preface of the Trinity as read today is the same one that appeared in the first text of the Saint Gregory the Great.

Next Sunday, we celebrate another great feast - Corpus Christi, where we celebrate the reality of the Blessed Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist. Considering things have significantly improved in terms of the pandemic, we will have a Corpus Christi Procession next Sunday after the 11:30 Mass.
