Next Sunday - Palm Sunday - is the start of Holy Week. I encourage you to participate in the liturgies that bring us through Holy Week, beginning with Holy Thursday. In fact one beautiful aspect of Holy Week is the Exsultet: The Proclamation of Easter. As you might recall, the Exsultet is sung at the beginning of the Mass, when the Church is dark - except the Paschal Candle which burns by the Ambo and represent Christ the light of the world. And the Exsultet begins :

Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven,
Exult, let Angel ministers of God exult,
Let the trumpet of salvation
Sound aloud our mighty King's triumph!

This prayer originates in the 5th century, so we have been offering this prayer for about 1,500 years. It is a beautiful prayer - and if you have a chance, I encourage you to take a look at this prayer ahead of time, it can be found on a link on the website called: The Exsultet - The Easter Proclamation (scroll down for the text).

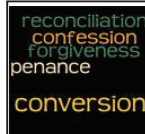
