

Dear Parishioner and Friends of St. Gregory Barbarigo Parish,

On behalf of my family, I would like to tank everyone who has responded with prayers and condolences since hearing the news of my mother's death on Tuesday, May 17th. Charlotte (aka Lottie) had reached 102 which, is pretty good, but in early May she fell and endured a painful fracture. She received an instant response from the fantastic staff at Dowling Gardens in Sparkill then was rushed to Nyack Hospital where she continued to receive great care. Within a week she was moved to the Physical Therapy floor where she started her therapy, but it was terribly painful, and even with pain management, it became impossible for her to endure, then her condition began to deteriorate. Well thankfully, I was able to visit Mom and with my brothers and sisters present, anointed her and gave the final blessing, which was not easy. But that is what we hope for - by the intercession of St. Joseph - a holy death. Mom had been consistently receiving Holy Communion until she was no longer able to, and every day she prayed the rosary, until she was no longer conscious.

Mom's funeral was on Friday, May 20th, at St. Margaret's in Pearl River, where my three brothers and three sisters and I grew up. She was buried at St. Anthony's with my father Daniel, in a grave not far from mine. So thank you again for your prayers and support, please remember to say a prayer for Lottie Fallon.
