
This Saturday is First Holy Communion, a happy time in the parish, when boys and girls have the opportunity PASTOR to begin a lifelong relationship with Christ, in the Eucharist which is the "source and summit of the

Christian life." At St. Gregory's part of the preparation for receiving is the requirement of students to come to Sunday Mass for the year preceding First Holy Communion. Hopefully, this reminds parents that this is the practice of faith, and an aspect of loving children is not depriving them of the grace from the Eucharist.

Speaking of the Holy Eucharist, in September, there will be a Eucharistic Procession and Holy Hour which will include people from all parishes in Rockland County; this event will be at the Marian Shrine. Another event at the Shrine will occur from May 4 to May 9: The Eucharist Miracles Exhibit which will include a First Class relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis.
