BECOMING CATHOLIC - Every year 1,000's of people come into the Catholic Church throughout the world. The usual path is through a Catholic parish and by participating in the RCIA process. So for instance there might be someone who has never been baptized, or someone who is coming from a different faith or a Catholic person who was baptized but never received the other sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. Well for those who would be interested - they would contact the parish and have a conversation with Fr. Fallon. Then the next step begins in early October, meeting each week, usually on Sunday mornings in the St. Joseph meeting room for an hour or so, to learn about the faith and also to pray together. Then at the Easter Vigil - they would receive the Sacraments and come fully into the Church. That is a rough outline of the RCIA process but what is essential is an RCIA team, that is, people from the parish who are willing to volunteer their time to help teach and answer questions. There is a book which is used, but volunteers are essential. Ideally, there are two teams of volunteers who take turns each weekend, that way a team is only teaching two Sundays each month. Before Covid we had two teams, but a couple who had volunteered moved away so we are down to one person. So - we need some volunteers to take up the reins and volunteer to be catechists for RCIA. One way a parish grows is by people becoming Catholic, for that to happen, we need volunteers who will make an effort to pass on our Faith. So please give it some thought and if you have any questions please speak to Fr. Fallon.
