BAPTISM: First and third Sundays at 1:00 pm. Parents may contact the Rectory to arrange for the baptism.

MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. If you would like to sign up for a specific hour, please go to the parish website and find the link to Adoration. Please come by for some quiet prayer and reflection.

RENOVATION NOTICE - Week 2—Well we

were supposed to begin renovations last Monday, May 22, but the tile shipment has been delayed. Now as you might realize, the weekly bulletin is completed on Tuesday of each week, then it is emailed to the vendor, who prints it, then ships it in time for the weekend. So, at this point in time, we are expecting the tile to arrive on Friday, May 26th. Presuming the tile arrives Friday, then Mass on Tuesday, May 30th, will be in the chapel. (Monday is Memorial Day; workmen will have the day off).

Once the job begins, if there are no complications, then the pews come out, the floor goes down, then the pews go back. The contractor, who has years of experience on the job, is confident that this project should not take more than two weeks. On June 4th, Sunday Mass will be moved to the gym, and very probably Mass on Sunday, June 11th. June 11th is the Feast of Corpus Christi. Usually Corpus Christi we have a procession and holy hour; this will not occur if we are still in the gym.

Now, regarding daily Mass, chairs have been brought in to accommodate the daily Mass community. Like the Church, the chapel will be open each day at 8:00 am for daily Mass. Regarding Adoration on Friday and Saturday: Adoration will discontinue during Mass, then resume after Mass is concluded.

Today we celebrate the beautiful Feast Day of Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost is one of the most ancient feasts on the Church calendar. Celebrated early enough to be mentioned in the Acts of Apostles (20:16) and St. Paul's first letter to the Corinthians (16:18). It is the fiftieth day after Easter, and it supplants the Jewish Feast of Pentecost, which took place 50 days after the Passover and celebrated the sealing of the Old Covenant on Mt. Sinai. Furthermore, it is the start of the public mission of the Church when the disciples continued the work of Christ through His Church. Pentecost is also the genesis of the sacrament of Confirmation.

Moving to more parochial matters, the big spring clean up last Saturday was washed out due to heavy rain. The following Saturday was Memorial Day Weekend, which is not a great time to look for volunteers, so this year it is canceled.
