MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. If you would like to sign up for a specific hour, please go to the parish website and find the link to Adoration. Please come by for some quiet prayer and reflection.

Well a lot has been accomplished with the installation of the new floor, since the last bulletin. Now as you might recall, this bulletin is submitted to the bulletin company Tuesday of each week; so there is a bit of a time lag between writing the bulletin and reading it on Sunday. At this point, the pews have been numbered and removed and stored in the Narthex, then the rug was pulled up. Secondly there were some structural repairs made to parts of the concrete slab. Then the work began on putting the tiles down. At this point about half of the tile is down and it is likely the floor and grout will be complete by Friday. But then – the pews have to be returned and affixed to the floor. Affixing the pews might take a few days. So at the time of this bulletin being written, it appears we will have Sunday Mass one more time in the school gymnasium, but next Sunday, God willing, we will be back in the Church.

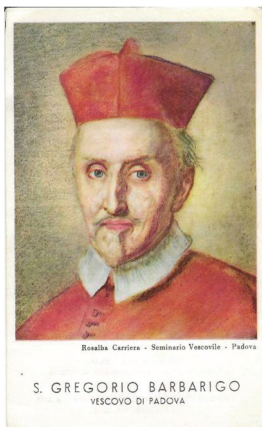
