

PASTOR

Presently the Church in the United States is in the process of the "Eucharistic Revival." This is an effort to reaffirm the centrality of the Eucharist in our parishes and in our lives. Locally this event is being celebrated in

various ways, including processions. Next Saturday September 30, there will be a Eucharistic Procession and presentation at the Marian Shrine which includes all parishes from Rockland County The event begins at 11:00 and finishes at 2:00. Parking will be in the back lot, which is near the large ball field, and if need be, parking will also be on the field. The St. Gregory's Banner will be present, so please find it and join in before we begin. There is a sign-up sheet in the Narthex, and part of the advantage of a signup sheet is when we put down our name, we are making a commitment to be there.

Now in addition to the Procession at the Marian Shrine, there is also a Eucharistic Congress for New York State; it will occur over three days, October 20 to October 22.
