MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

ARCHDIOCESE OF NEW YORK



Well today was the Parish Picnic – a happy time in the parish. Now as you might recall, the bulletin is printed before the weekend, so as the bulletin is being written we are making preparations. And the Parish Picnic is an important aspect of the Parish. Now granted, coming together on Sunday for the celebration of the Mass is central to who we are, but in addition to coming together for Mass it is good to connect with other people who are also Catholic from our parish beyond Sunday Mass. For instance the Men's group: That Man is You, and the Women's group: Walking with Purpose. Also CYO basketball, coffee and donuts after Sunday Mass, Knights of Columbus, and the Parish Picnic, etc. The common denominator to all these events is that we are united by Christ. And it is good that we make an effort to be part of these events – because it helps the parish to be vital and also helps to fortify each of us in the faith.

Saturday September 30th was the Eucharistic Procession at the Marian Shrine; the next event which reaffirms our commitment to Christ is the Eucharistic Congress for New York State; it will occur over three days, October 20 to October 22. The event will happen in Auriesville, New York, which is a bit north and west of Albany. The bus ride would take about 2 ½ hours. At the parish council meeting we discussed getting a bus and going up in time for the 11:00 Mass. If you would be interested in going, please let Fr. Fallon or one of the deacons know; this is not an obligation, but if we get a lot of feedback we will try to get a bus.

CCD – special teachers needed. Presently we have several students from Grammar school who have missed the beginning years of catechesis. Typically these students are placed in the CCD class which corresponds to their age, but then in addition they come for several weeks to be “caught up” for some of the fundamentals which they have missed. This will include two groups, lower grades and upper grades. Instruction would be about an hour a week for about six weeks and would occur in a school classroom while other CCD classes are occurring. If you are willing and able, it would be great if you could help out in this capacity. Passing our Catholic Faith onto the next generation is essential and lives the words of Christ who said: Go and teach all that I have taught you. If you have some questions of how this will work, please call the rectory and speak to Mrs. Deirdre Armida.
