MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. If you would like to sign up for a specific hour, please go to the parish website and find the link to Adoration. Please come by for some quiet prayer and reflection.

THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE:

We partner with local food pantries by helping to combat the hunger problem in Rockland County. Donations are at an all time low and with the holidays approaching, we are being asked to help once again. Items requested are: peanut butter/jelly, tuna or other canned fish, canned ham, soup, canned beans, macaroni and cheese, pasta, rice, instant potatoes, canned vegetables, canned fruits, cereals, oatmeal packets or canisters, spaghetti sauce, juice boxes, cake mixes, pudding/jell-o, crackers, breakfast bars, coffee, tea. These may be left in the Feeding Our Neighbors box in the Narthex. Our principal social service agency is the Catholic Charities Community Services of Rockland located here in Haverstraw. The collection of a frozen turkey can be dropped off in the truck outside the church on Monday November 20 until noon and they will be delivered to Catholic Charities later that day.



Here at St. Gregory's we have the Wailing Wall on the north side of the Narthex. As you might know, when people have special intentions, they write them on a piece of paper, then attach it to the bulletin board, and periodically we include those intentions in the Prayer of the Faithful. But I think it is time to find a moderator of the Wailing Wall. Presently there is not specific method of moving the intentions off the board though it does occur periodically. It would be helpful if there was a volunteer who could remove the intentions for the first Sunday of each month. This would require placing the intentions in a basket, then the basket would be brought up at the offertory at every Mass that Sunday. If you are able to assist – please call the rectory and leave your name and phone number.

Moving from the Narthex to home -- Parishioners of St. Gregory's have access to the web channel called FORMED. FORMED is an innovative online platform where you can have access to a wide range of top-quality faith formation resources. Our parish has received another full year subscription. This can be compared to Netflix for Catholics, but so much more. It includes Catholic study programs, movies, audio presentations and even eBooks, from various apostolates. FORMED is also compatible with Smart TVs. For instance, the popular "Brother Francis" can be viewed at home.
