Dear friends in the Lord:

As we approach the annual collection for the *Retirement Fund for Religious* – an appeal that benefits nearly 25,000 elderly Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests – I reflect on the ministry of women and men religious – past and present – and I am grateful for the ways they have shaped my own faith. Helen Hayes - New Ministry for St. Gregory's

Before COVID-19 a visiting priest would celebrate Mass at Helen Hayes Hospital every Saturday afternoon for the patients who were Catholic; this ended with COVID-19 and has not re-

sumed. Looking to serve the patients who are Catholic, we contacted Helen Hayes Hospital to see about the possibility of E.M.s from St. Gregory's bringing Holy Communion every Sunday. The administration at Helen Hayes Hospital agreed to our beginning this new ministry.

Presently we are looking to have two teams of six EM's to alternate Sundays, that way the commitment is just for two Sundays per month. Each team will include a coordinator to help organize the visits. Presently we are probably going to go after the 9:30 Sunday Mass, that way if there are hosts which are remaining, they can be brought back to the Church to be returned to the tabernacle. We are presently working with Eucharistic Ministers to put this new ministry in place, hopefully by sometime in December. We will probably have to train some new E.M.s to help get this work done, but we can begin all the same. If you are interested in becoming an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist, who will be able to help with the Helen Hayes Ministry, please speak to Fr. Fallon after Sunday Mass.
