MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. Today we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, when the Three Kings came and paid homage to the Christ Child. So it is fitting to extend thanks to all the volunteers who worked to set up the outside Nativity and also did such a great job preparing the Church, it really looks beautiful – so thank you again. Turning back to the Feast day – many countries still celebrate The Epiphany on January 6, which is the twelfth day after Christmas. In the United States, January 6 is not a holiday, nor is it a holy day of obligation, so when Epiphany was celebrated on the 6th, the feast would come and go and most people would miss it. At one time, January 6 was called Little Christmas and after that day, most people took down the Christmas tree, but even that distinction had begun to fade. In 1983 the bishops in the United States asked Rome if the Epiphany could be moved to the first Sunday after January 1. Rome granted permission, and is celebrated as the Epiphany.

The term Epiphany pertains to the Three Kings having an extraordinary realization or “epiphany” when they came upon the Christ Child. Guided by the Holy Spirit, they realized this little baby was far more than simply an earthly king. In Latin America, the feast day is commonly called “Three Kings” and is an important celebration. The Three Kings expressed their reverence for Christ and like the Three Kings - we also express our reverence when we come into church and genuflect in the direction of the tabernacle, acknowledging the Divine Presence.
