BAPTISM: First and third Sundays at 1:00 pm. Parents may contact the Rectory to arrange for the baptism.

MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. If you would like to sign up for a specific hour, please go to the parish website and find the link to Adoration. Please come by for some quiet prayer and reflection.

REQUESTS FOR SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Occasionally a person is asked to be a sponsor at a Baptism or Confirmation. A Sponsor certificate comes from the parish and testifies to the fact the person is Catholic and:

1. The sponsor lives within the parish of St. Gregory Barbarigo and is registered.
2. The sponsor also needs to be consistently at Sunday Mass each week, that is what it is to be practicing. Some opt to go to a different parish or a shrine, but if that is the case, we cannot honestly say that person is an active parishioner because he or she is not.
3. Additionally, a person needs to be at least 16 years old.
4. Have received the sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Communion and Confirmation.
5. And if married, married in the Church.

If you know an event is a few weeks away, contact the parish ahead of time. Sometimes people think that since they were confirmed here then a sponsor certificate is somehow automatic; well no, that's not the case. Again, the above criteria need to be met to satisfy that requirement.



Last Monday, January 8, we celebrated the feast of Baptism of the Lord, which marks the end of the Christmas Season. Thanks are extended to all those who sent cards, cookies, candy, and other treats to the Rectory, that is certainly thoughtful. Now we move back to Ordinary time, but only for a few weeks, Ash Wednesday is February 14, which also happens to be Valentine's Day. For those who may be looking to celebrate Valentine's Day – a common practice this year is to move it from Wednesday the 14th to the day before – Tuesday the 13th; remembering that Ash Wednesday is a day of fast abstinence.

Lastly – I am looking forward to the CYO Pancake breakfast next Sunday – it's great to come together as a community in our Parish Center for a great breakfast and to support CYO. I hope to see you there.

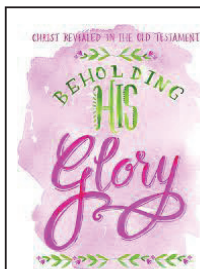
