BAPTISM: First and third Sundays at 1:00 pm. Parents may contact the Rectory to arrange for the baptism.

MATRIMONY: Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program. Contact the Rectory to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or homebound due to advancement of age, call the Rectory to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home. When you go to a hospital be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL: We have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 hours a week, From Friday morning at 8:00 a.m. until Saturday morning 9:00 a.m. The chapel is completely open from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., the key code is needed for entry. If you would like to sign up for a specific hour, please go to the parish website and find the link to Adoration. Please come by for some quiet prayer and reflection.

REQUESTS FOR SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Occasionally a person is asked to be a sponsor at a Baptism or Confirmation. A Sponsor certificate comes from the parish and testifies to the fact the person is Catholic and:

- The sponsor lives within the parish of St. Gregory Barbarigo and is registered.
- The sponsor also needs to be consistently at Sunday Mass each week, that is what it is to be practicing. Some opt to go to a different parish or a shrine, but if that is the case, we cannot honestly say that person is an active parishioner because he or she is not.
- Additionally, a person needs to be at least 16 years old.
- Have received the sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Communion and Confirmation.
- And if married, married in the Church.

If you know an event is a few weeks away, contact the parish ahead of time. Sometimes people think that since they were confirmed here then a sponsor certificate is somehow automatic; well no, that's not the case. Again, the above criteria need to be met to satisfy that requirement.



Last Saturday we sent our first team of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist (EMs) to **Helen Hayes Hospital**. We have six EMs (though one was not able to make it last Saturday) on our Alpha Team. We need six more EMs for our second team – the Beta Team. Asking the same EMs to go every Saturday is really too much, so our plan is to have two teams of six. The teams will take turns each weekend. So in other words the Alpha Team will bring Communion the first Saturday, the Beta Team would bring communion the second Saturday, then the Alpha Team would bring Communion the third Saturday, etc. **So we need six more volunteers**; current EMs are welcome and also new people who are willing to help. We would have a briefing beforehand and also train the new EMs. Incredibly Helen Hayes Hospital can have anywhere from 30 to 40 **Catholic patients** at one time. Turning to the old axiom: Many hands make light labor. So patients who are Catholic were able to receive Communion last weekend, but none will receive this weekend because we need more people to help. EMs meet at the Church at 3:50, are given pyxes with hosts, then they go to Helen Hayes Hospital. The Hospital had a list prepared so each EM would visit in one area. They were done in about an hour. Hopefully by January 31 we will have some more volunteers to help with this very important ministry. If you like to volunteer, call the rectory or speak to Fr. Fallon after Mass.

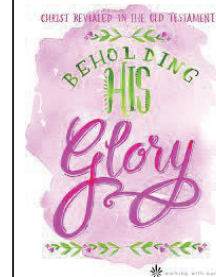
