TAIZÉ PRAYER WITH FLOWER OF CARMEL

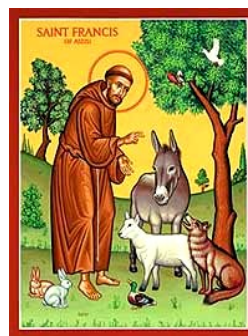

In FY19-20, the total was \$8,842. *Copier paper was the biggest expense. The much lower figure this past fiscal year is attributed to the cessation of many programs during the pandemic.

BAPTISM: Contact the parish office to begin the required preparation while pregnant or awaiting adoption. Baptisms will not be scheduled until preparation is complete.

MARRIAGE: Couples seeking marriage must make arrangements with a Priest or Deacon a minimum of six months before setting a wedding date. At least one party must be a registered member of St. Rose.
