

OUR FOUNDING PASTOR

Rev. Joseph Francis Byron

Fr. Byron was born on Sept. 9, 1924 in Albany, N.Y. He served in the Army in Germany during World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart and Bronze Star. He studied for the priesthood at Theological College in Washington, D.C. and was ordained in 1953. He served as an associate pastor at St. Jane de Chantal in Bethesda from 1955 to 1962, and in the 1960s, also served as chaplain at Xaverian College in Silver Spring.



In 1972, Fr. Byron became the founding pastor of St. Rose, serving here for 11 years. During his St. Rose years, he was much beloved by parishioners for his empowerment of the laity and for starting many of our beloved community traditions and ministries such as Fiesta and Gift Teams. Ask some of our long-term parishioners—they'll have lots of wonderful stories to share about Fr. Byron!

After leaving St. Rose, he served at Our Lady in Potomac until his retirement. Fr. Byron died from complications of Alzheimer's disease at Manor Care in Potomac on Sept. 29, 1997. He is buried in St. Gabriel's Cemetery in Potomac.


NUESTRO PASTOR FUNDADOR

Rev. Joseph Francis Byron

Padre Byron nació el 9 de sept. de 1924 en Albany, N.Y. Sirvió en el ejército en Alemania durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial y recibió la condecoración del Corazón Púrpura y la Estrella de Bronce. Estudió para el sacerdocio en la universidad de Theological College en Washington, D.C. y fue ordenado en 1953. Se desempeñó como pastor asociado en San Jane de Chantal en Bethesda de 1955 a 1962, y en la década de 1960, también se desempeñó como capellán en la universidad de Xaverian College en Silver Spring.

En 1972, el Padre Byron se convirtió en el pastor fundador de Sta. Rosa, sirviendo aquí durante 11 años. Durante sus años en Sta. Rosa, fue muy querido por los feligreses por fortalecer a los laicos y por iniciar muchas de nuestras queridas tradiciones y ministerios comunitarios, como Fiesta y los Equipos de Dones (Gift Teams.) ¡Pregúntenles a algunos de nuestros feligreses más antiguos — ellos tendrán muchas historias maravillosas para compartir sobre el Padre Byron!

Después de salir de Sta. Rosa, sirvió en Our Lady en Potomac hasta su retiro. Padre Byron murió por complicaciones de la enfermedad de Alzheimer en Manor Care en Potomac el 29 de septiembre de 1997. Está enterrado en el cementerio de San Gabriel en Potomac.



Saint of the Week

Saint Germaine was born in Pibrac, France in 1579 to poor parents. Her story is a heart wrenching one. She was born with a deformed right arm and hand, and her mother died when she was an infant. Her father remarried, but her stepmother brutally abused and neglected her.

As a child Germaine suffered from scrofula, a disfiguring form of tuberculosis which causes swelling and lesions on the side of the neck. Already sick, abused, and starving, she was forced to sleep in barn with sheep she tended.

Despite everything, Germaine lived each day tending her flock with joy and in prayer. Mary and Jesus became her friends. She shared what little she had and taught the children of the village about God's love. A rosary made of string knots was her constant companion. She attended Mass every day, leaving her sheep in care of guardian angels. Her flock was never attacked by wolves and never wandered. Some claimed to see the waters of the flooded river part so she could get to Mass.

She is often portrayed with an apron full of flowers because one winter day her stepmother accused her of stealing bread from the house and hiding it her apron. But when she was seized and forced to open the apron an abundance of spring flowers tumbled forth. It was this incident that compelled the villagers and even her parents to recognize her holiness. Germaine died at 22, her poor body was found by her father, in the barn where she slept. She was buried in the village church. More than forty years later, her body was accidentally exhumed and found to be incorrupt. She was canonized by Pope Pius IX in 1867 and inscribed into the canon of virgins.
