My Dear Parishioners,

The turning of the calendar to February means the archdiocesan Annual Appeal is at hand. I am happy to share with you that the 2022 Annual Appeal attained its overall goal of \$11 million. On behalf of Cardinal Gregory, thank you to all our families who made a contribution in 2022 to help the archdiocese reach its goal. We reached 89% of our own parish goal, with a total of \$123,864 in pledges from St. Rose parishioners.

Now, I ask you to prayerfully consider your gift to the 2023 Annual Appeal. If you are not familiar with the Annual Appeal, you may wonder how it is different and separate from your offertory giving to the parish. First, the Annual Appeal unites us with our archbishop in serving the many, charitable needs of the Church of Washington. Second, the Annual Appeal funds ministries that our parish could not sustain on our own, such as seminarian formation, campus ministry programs, and deaf and disabilities ministries. Third, the Annual Appeal supports our parish ministerial life, from schools and catechesis, to family and pro-life ministries, to many more in between.

The Annual Appeal is a call to stewardship. It is not mandatory. This means that the many vibrant ministries we have in the archdiocese are the result of families such as your own who have responded generously each year with your free will offering. I am particularly grateful, as a priest of the archdiocese, for your contribution which helps to inspire new vocations and form our new generations of priests.

I am also asked to remind you that, as in every year, 100% of your gift to the Annual Appeal is restricted to the ministries that are a part of the Annual Appeal and cannot be used for any other purpose. Furthermore, your gift will be credited towards our 2023 parish goal of \$143,400. It is also important to note that for every dollar given in excess of our parish goal, 50% will come back to St. Rose! You can read more about the 2023 Annual Appeal at appeal.adw.org.

Next weekend will be our commitment weekend. Thank you in advance for your prayerful commitment to the 2023 Annual Appeal. Your steadfast generosity not only is a source of inspiration for me, but a force for good in our Church today.

La entrada al mes de febrero significa que estamos próximos a la Campaña Anual de la Arquidiócesis. Me complace comunicarles que la Campaña Anual 2022 cumplió su objetivo general de \$11 millones. En nombre del Cardenal Gregory, agradezco a todas nuestras familias que contribuyeron en 2022 para ayudar a la Arquidiócesis a alcanzar su objetivo. Alcanzamos el 89% de nuestra propia meta parroquial, con un total de \$123,864 en promesas de donaciones por parte de los feligreses de Sta. Rosa.

Ahora, les pido que consideren a la luz de la oración su donación a la Campaña Anual 2023. Si no están al tanto del significado de la Campaña Anual, tal vez se pregunten en qué se diferencia de la colecta de la parroquia. En tercer lugar, la Campaña Anual apoya la vida ministerial de nuestra parroquia, desde las escuelas y la catequesis hasta los ministerios de familia y provida, junto a muchos otros.

La Campaña Anual es un llamado a la corresponsabilidad. No es obligatoria. Esto significa que los muchos ministerios dinámicos que tenemos en la Arquidiócesis son el resultado de familias como la de ustedes que han respondido con generosidad cada año con su ofrenda voluntaria. Como sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis, estoy especialmente agradecido por su contribución, que ayuda a inspirar nuevas vocaciones y a formar nuestras nuevas generaciones de sacerdotes.

También me piden que les recuerde que, como cada año, el 100% de sus donaciones a la Campaña Anual está reservado a los ministerios que forman parte de la Campaña Anual y no puede ser utilizado para ningún otro propósito. Además, sus donaciones contribuirán a lograr nuestra meta parroquia para el 2023 de \$143,400. ¡También es importante notar que por cada dólar adicional que donen, el 50% regresará a Sta. Rosa! 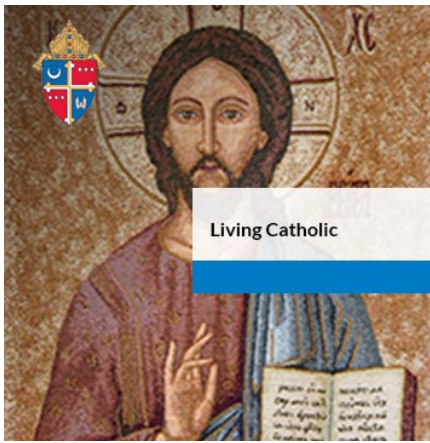

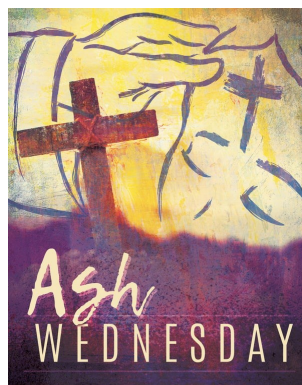
O.W.L.S. MINI-RETREAT: IT'S A BEAUTIFUL DAY
