ANNUAL MISSION APPEAL VISITING LITTLE SISTERS OF MARY IMMACULATE OF GULU IN UGANDA (LSMIG) TO SPEAK AT ALL MASSES NEXT WEEKEND JUNE 28-29

Next weekend please welcome The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG), they are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu, in Northern Uganda (East Africa). The Sisters are dedicated to serving people of northern Uganda who are emerging from nearly 30 years of devastating civil war, sexual violence and an influx of refugees from South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The Sisters are responding courageously with limited resources to the needs of refugee child-mothers and children in the refugee camps through Catholic education and Catholic youth outreach programs.

Sister Mary Cecilia Draru, USA Mission Coordinator, says they have developed a Catholic Elementary Education Center with a focus on vocational training, daycare and kindergarten to support education of these child-mothers and their babies. Our Sisters have made this bold move to break the cycle of teenage pregnancy and child motherhood and to give these girls and their babies a second chance through this initiative.
