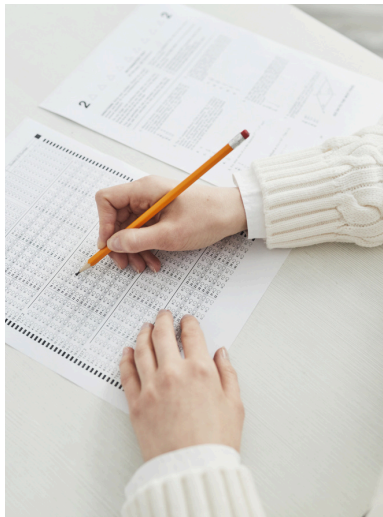
TIMELINE OF EVENTS

School-wide objective tests will be administered after school starting November 18th and will be completed by December 12th. Subjective events will be held January 13-15.

For most events, the top three finishers will advance to the District Meet. Some events only take the top two finalists. Results from the tests will be emailed and then top finishers will be posted in Tiger Times.

The District Meet will be held at Holy Cross in San Antonio on Friday, **February 6, 2026**.

Students who place in the top two at District will advance to the State Meet, which will be held on Saturday, **May 2, 2026** at Texas State University in San Marcos.
