### WHAT IS ASH WEDNESDAY?

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. Catholics receive ashes in the shape of a cross on their foreheads. This sign serves as a solemn reminder of human mortality, the importance of the spiritual life, and the need for repentance.

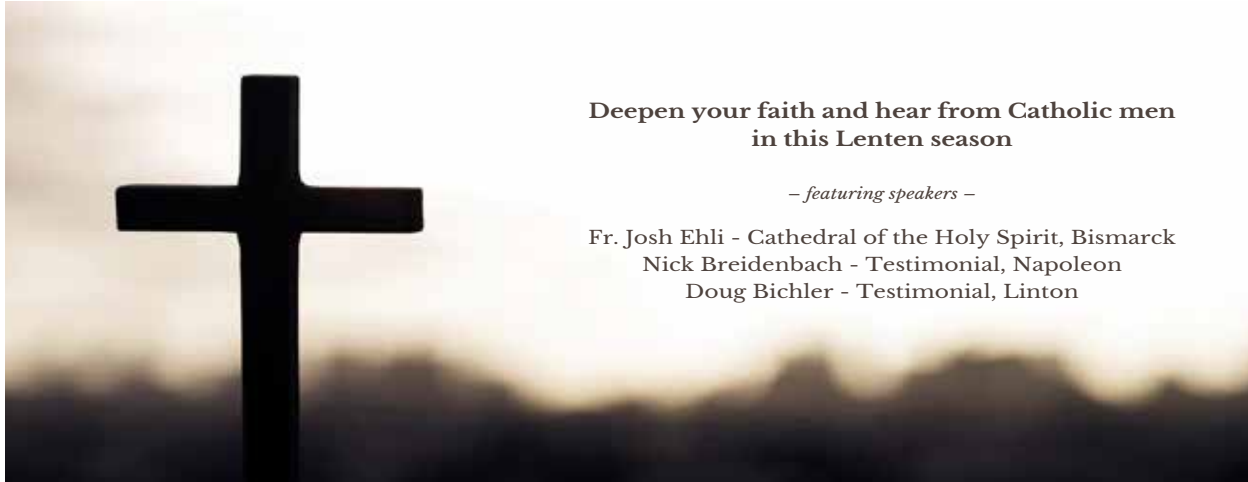

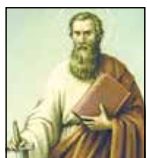

### Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word
