FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS



The Church has a special dedication for each month of the year. For example, May is a month dedicated to remembering and honoring Mary, our Blessed Mother. July is the month dedicated to recalling and honoring the Precious Blood of Jesus. June is the month dedicated to remembering and honoring the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

In the seventeenth Century, Jesus visited a religious sister in France and asked her to promote devotion to his Most Sacred Heart. He explained how much He loves all people saying, "This is a heart that loves so much and receives so little love in return." He also explained that He is offended and wounded by sin which moves the hearts of believers to conversion and to make reparation for their sins and the sins of the world. This notion of how sin wounds the heart of the Lord is a powerful motivator for the disciples of Jesus.

Jesus made several promises to those who live a life devoted to his Sacred Heart. He explained that devotion to His heart consists in regular Mass, monthly confession, prayer for love of Him and for the conversion of sinners. Following are the twelve promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

12 Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- 4. I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- 5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- 9. I will bless every place in which an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.
- 10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.
- 12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in My disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

I hope that you will all consider seriously devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. After all, it is Jesus Himself who is extending this invitation.

2 CORINTHIANS 5:10


