WE'RE AT THE HALF WAY POINT

We recently passed the halfway point of Lent. Hopefully our Lenten practices will bear fruit in our lives. However, with the business of life, or for other reasons, we may not have begun our practice of Lent. I want to say today that it is never too late to begin our Lenten practices.

Let me remind you of what Lent is about. In Lent, we keep our eyes focused on Holy Week and the death and the resurrection of Jesus. During Lent, we enter this Paschal Mystery. We choose to die and rise with Jesus, putting our sins to death and attempting to enter more deeply into the life of love that Jesus teaches us.

The regular practices of Lent are prayer, fasting and works of mercy. We do more of these during Lent. All of these help us to die and rise with Jesus.

Some of the most common practices of Lent are more frequent Mass attendance, more frequent confessions, stations of the cross, sacrifices that we offer to God out of love for Him and others, et al.

Please keep in mind that it is never too late to start! Happy Lent!


