FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

JESUS AND THE EUCHARIST



When I was a freshman in high school, I worked a few years as a caddy at a local country club, Rockaway River Country Club in Denville. Caddies Day was on Mondays and I learned to play golf by playing there with my other friends. With golf, there are things that you need to learn to do if you want to progress in the sport. You check your stance. You check your grip. You check your posture. You learn the distances that you can send the ball with each of the clubs. You learn to do all of these things because even having one of them off can have a negative effect on your game.

The same is true for the Christian life. There are things we must do if we want to live this life well. I will point out two of these today. One concerns Jesus. The true Christian places Jesus at the center of his life. He makes Jesus his teacher and Lord. We try always to do God's will. We seek to please the Lord in all that we do. Seeking to do God's will brings us into proper alignment with the Kingdom of God. Seeking to do God's will brings us into the Kingdom here on earth and prepares for entry into the Kingdom when we die.

Another absolutely essential part of the Christian life is where we place the Eucharist, the Mass, in our lives. The best place to meet with Jesus is in the Eucharist. Jesus feeds and strengthens us for Christian living through the Eucharist. We need Jesus in the Eucharist. We need His nourishment every week, every Sunday. As Christians, we need to give Jesus His proper place and we need regular Sunday Mass if we hope to live this life well!

"Moses said to the people: 'If only you would heed the voice of the Lord, your God, and keep His commandments and statutes that are written in the book of the law, when you return to the Lord, your God, with all your heart and all your soul...it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out."





