FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

DIVINE MERCY AND THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS



July is the Month of the Precious Blood of Jesus. I recently noticed that it falls after June, the Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This sequence of heart and blood is natural because the Precious Blood that flowed from the Heart of Jesus is a part of Him and manifests the Love that Jesus has for us.

The teachings of Jesus on the Divine Mercy that were given to us through Saint Faustina Kowalska help us to appreciate the blessings of the Blood of Jesus. John's Gospel teaches us that blood and water flowed from the loving Heart of Jesus after His Heart was pierced by the soldier's lance. Jesus explained to St. Faustina that His Blood reminds us of the Eucharist where Jesus feeds us with His loving presence. The Water that flows from His Heart reminds us of the Holy Spirit who resides in our hearts. The Water also reminds us of the waters of Baptism that call us to put an end to sin and to begin to live and love eternally with Jesus. The teachings of the Divine Mercy indicate to us that the Blood of Jesus is life-giving for us.

The Blood of Jesus is precious because it is a part of who Jesus is. His blood is not just a possession of His. It is a part of Him and for this reason it is sacred, precious to us. I cannot help but recall the scene from the movie, The Passion of the Christ, where the wife of Pontius Pilate gives linen cloths to the Blessed Mother so that she may collect the blood of Jesus that covered the floor of the place there Jesus was horribly scourged by the soldiers. One cannot help but know that the Blood of Jesus is sacred. It could not be left on the dirty floor of Pilate's home. It could not be mistreated by the soldiers who would walk on that blood. We know in the depths of our beings that the Blood of Christ is sacred because it is a part of Jesus. The Blood of Jesus gave Him life and gives us life, too!

"THIS IS THE MAN THAT I HAVE PREPARED FOR YOU"

This past Tuesday, we celebrated the Feast Day of Louis and Zelie Martin, the parents of St. Therese of Lisieux. Zelie was raised by her parents and her Catholic school teachers to have a deep faith in the Lord. She learned that it pleases God when we seek to know and follow His will. It is like the petition in the Lord's Prayer where we say, "Your will be done!" Seeking God's will, Zelie attempted to join the community of the Sisters of Charity. However, she was not accepted due to health reasons. She continued to seek God's will in her life. She recognized that God was calling her to the vocation of marriage. She eventually met a very good man whose charity and faith impressed her. She heard God's voice in her heart tell her, "This is the man that I have prepared for you." He was Louis Martin. Both would become saints in the Catholic Church and they raised five wonderful children.

Clearly, marriage is a vocation, a calling. Every one of us is called to do God's will in our lives. Please be sure to share this truth with your children and grandchildren! We all are called to do God's will in our lives and He will reveal His will if we learn to listen.
