MATRIMONY AND THE SPIRITUAL LIFE



In the Book of Revelation, Jesus is presented as the groom and the Church as his bride (Rev. 19:7). It says there that "the wedding day of the Lamb has come and his bride has made herself ready." God's plan for the marriage of man and woman is a great way to understand the entire Christian life and the New Covenant between God and his Church. Man and woman, the Groom and the Bride, seek union with each other. They seek to share their lives and to have one mind and one heart.

Jesus is the Eternal Word and we seek to become one with the Word through listening and learning and living by the Word of God. Through mental prayer and by meeting with Jesus in the Sacraments, we seek to become one with him. "God is love" (1 John 4). We seek in the Christian life with the help of God's grace and the sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Confession, to perfect God's presence, charity, love, in us just as the bride and the groom are one flesh and one in their goals, labors and aspirations.

Just as the bride and groom seek to be one in the sacrament of Matrimony, every baptized person is invited by God to seek union with himself. Just as there can be a kind of ecstasy for the bride and the groom in the living of their sacrament, so the Christian can be blessed with a wonderful joy and peace in the experience of union with God. In this union with himself, God can give us a joy and peace that the world cannot give (john 16: 22 and John 14:27).

PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

"Jesus was praying in a certain place and when he had finished, one of His disciples said to Him: 'Lord teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.' He said, 'When you pray, say....And I tell you, ask and you shall receive, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened to you.'"

How familiar! Can I picture Jesus at prayer, as when He was in the garden of Gethsemane, asking His Father to take the cup 'but not My will, but Yours be done?' Can I picture Him praying as He blessed the loaves and fishes? Can I see Him at prayer as He prepared the breakfast for the apostles at the seashore? Can I hear His prayer as He said 'little girl get up?' Jesus at prayer. He not only provided us with the words we recite so frequently, but we also hear Him tell us – right now - ask, seek, knock. Do I accept His teaching as He taught the disciple who asked?
