### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

## FROM THE PRODIGAL SON "Everything I have is Yours"



The parable of the Prodigal Son was composed by Jesus. Some literary students have called it the greatest piece of literature of all time! In addition to its beauty, being an inspired parable, this lesson has the power to teach us many things about God and about the Kingdom of God.

There are three characters in the story, the father and the two sons. For myself, I think of their family home as the Kingdom of God. The younger son asks for his inheritance and decides to leave home, to leave the Kingdom. With what he receives as a share of the inheritance, the younger son is able to function for a short time, but then his savings are exhausted. This reminded me of ourselves when we drift away from prayer and the sacraments. The graces that God gives us in prayer can last for just so long. We can use them up. To live the Christian life well, we must remain connected to God. Jesus said, "I am the vine and you are the branches." In this connection, we are fed. Breaking away, we are living on a limited supply of God's grace.

The older son refuses to join in the celebration of his brother's return. He was invited to the feast. He could have partaken in a marvelous meal. He was invited to share in the welcoming gestures of their father, but he was resisting being a part of his father's heartfelt celebration of his brother's safe return. He was disappointed that the celebration was about his brother and not about himself.

The older brother was never in danger as was the younger brother. The Father tells the older son that, "Everything I have is yours." This statement of the father is quite a revelation. This reminded me of a teaching by St. John of the Cross. St. John explains that God's Word is like an endless vein in a gold mine. We can follow the vein and never exhaust the gifts of God. God always has more to give us. "Seek and you will find." God encourages us to keep coming, to keep seeking. There is always more that He wishes to give us! What a great God we have!

#### **24 - HOUR EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Also known as Eucharistic Adoration Is adoration of Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist.

The Eucharist is the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus under the appearance of bread and wine. Exposition is the placement of the sacred host outside the tabernacle for public adoration. The Eucharist is displayed in a special holder, a monstrance, placed on the altar.

Our church has 24-hour adoration where the Blessed Sacrament is exposed from Thursday at 5 pm until Friday at 5 pm. Individuals ("adorers") commit to taking turns being there around the clock. We have several openings in our adoration schedule. We especially need volunteers during our night hours from Thursday night until Friday morning where the sacrifice to attend is greater.

St. Alphonsus Liguori commented on Eucharistic Adoration: "Of all devotions, that of adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the greatest after the sacraments, the one dearest to God and the one most helpful to us."

Con estas palabras del profeta Isaías la Iglesia nos invita hoy a la alegría, en la mitad del itinerario penitencial de la Cuaresma. La alegría y la luz son el tema dominante de la liturgia de hoy. El evangelio narra la historia de "un hombre ciego de nacimiento" (Jn 9, 1). Al verlo, Jesús hizo barro con la saliva, se lo untó en los ojos y le dijo: "Ve a lavarte a la piscina de Siloé (que significa "Enviado"). Él fue, se lavó, y volvió con la vista" (Jn 9, 6-7). El ciego de nacimiento representa al hombre marcado por el pecado, que desea conocer la verdad sobre sí mismo y sobre su destino, pero se ve impedido por una enfermedad congénita. Sólo Jesús puede curarlo: él es "la luz del mundo" (Jn 9, 5). Al confiar en él, todo ser humano espiritualmente ciego de nacimiento tiene la posibilidad de "volver a la luz", es decir, de nacer a la vida sobrenatural.

Además de la curación del ciego, el evangelio da gran relieve a la incredulidad de los fariseos, que se niegan a reconocer el milagro, dado que Jesús lo ha realizado en sábado, violando, a su parecer, la ley de Moisés. Se manifiesta así una elocuente paradoja, que Cristo mismo resume con estas palabras: "Para un juicio he venido yo a este mundo: para que los que no ven, vean, y los que ven, se queden ciegos" (Jn 9, 39). Para quien encuentra a Jesús, no hay términos medios: o reconoce que lo necesita a él y su luz, o elige prescindir de él. En este último caso, tanto a quien se considera justo ante Dios como a quien se considera ateo, la misma presunción les impide abrirse a la conversión auténtica. Amadísimos hermanos y hermanas, nadie debe cerrar su corazón a Cristo. A quien lo acoge, él le da la luz de la fe, una luz capaz de transformar los corazones y, por consiguiente, las mentalidades y las situaciones sociales, políticas y económicas dominadas por el pecado. "Creo, Señor" (Jn 9, 38). Cada uno de nosotros, como el ciego de nacimiento, debe estar dispuesto a profesar humildemente su adhesión a él.
